DAY 1 : ARRIVAL HALIFAX, NS

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DAY 3 : HALIFAX, NS TO CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI

Learn about the Mi'kmaq people at the Millbrook Cultural & Heritage Centre before crossing Confederation Bridge, the world's longest continuous multi-span bridge, to Prince Edward Island. Check into your Charlottetown accommodation for a two-night stay and enjoy a theatre performance by local entertainers at the Confederation Centre of the Arts (a substitution may be necessary due to the theatre schedule). **(Continental Breakfast)**

DAY 4 : PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TOURING

Enjoy a free morning in Charlottetown, Canada's birthplace, or join a complimentary walking tour of the city. This afternoon, tour the scenic North Shore of the island. Drive by red cliffs, white beaches, gently sloping sand dunes and green fields of Prince Edward Island National Park and visit Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place, the alluring inspiration of Lucy Maud Montgomery's classic books. Experience true Maritime hospitality this evening at a traditional hall-style lobster supper. **(Breakfast, Dinner)**

DAY 5 : CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI TO HALIFAX, NS

Ferry over the Northumberland Strait back to Nova Scotia for a free afternoon and one last night in Halifax. **(Breakfast)**
