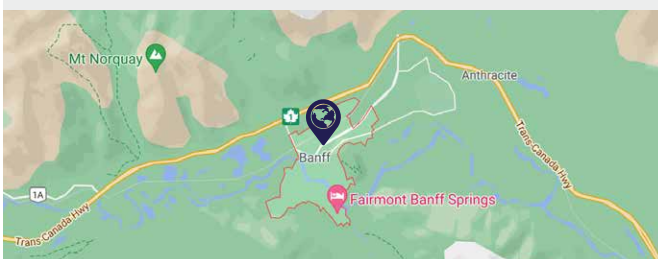
Only 1 ½ hour from Calgary, Banff is a quaint resort town located within the national park of the same name. The peaks of the Rundle and Cascade Mountains, part of the Rocky Mountains, dominate its skyline. On Banff Avenue, the main thoroughfare, stores and restaurants mingle with castle-style hotels and souvenir stores.

This 3 nights package allows you to discover this wonderful town at your own pace.

Day 1 : Calgary – transfer to Banff

After arriving into Calgary, you'll travel to Banff by scheduled coach service (on request). Check into the hotel and settle into your Fairmont Room with the rest of the day at leisure but you may want to take a walk in this eclectic town.

The town of Banff is a spirited place, alive with adventure and wonder. In all directions you're surrounded by strikingly beautiful and rugged mountains that seem to burst straight out of the ground. The lively streets of downtown are lined with top-class restaurants, bars, and shops, as well as a vibrant range of art galleries and museums. The locals are warm, open, and genuinely connected to the inspiring environment in which they live.

Day 2 - Banff

Once you've finished breakfast, do one of the more popular things in Banff - take the Gondola up Sulphur Mountain. The Banff Sightseeing Gondola is located five minutes' drive or a 25 minute bus ride from the town of Banff. The eight-minute ride takes guests to a lofty altitude of 7,486 feet. Once at the top, enjoy the restaurants, cafés, short hiking trails and new interpretive centre. If you are feeling adventurous, walk along the ridge line of Sulphur Mountain to see the Cosmic Ray Station, a historic site of Canada built to study cosmic rays.

This afternoon, enjoy stunning mountain scenery as you take a moment to relax and soak in the natural warmth. The Canadian Rockies Hot Springs are owned and operated by Parks Canada and are located right next to the Banff Gondola.

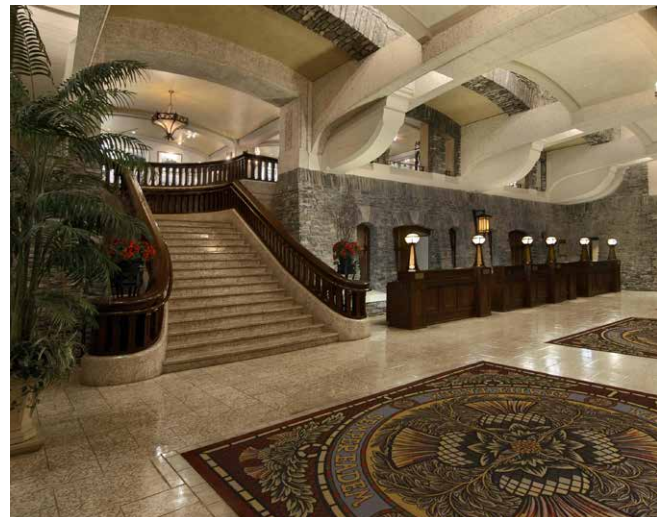
Overnight: The Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel



Day 3 - Banff

After breakfast, a mini-bus will pick you up at 8:30am for your Banff and Its Wildlife in Winter Tour. Take an unexpected winter excursion through the landscape of Banff as you search for the park's famous wildlife.

Head out on a nature-spotting tour to observe animals and learn about their ability to survive the cold winter months. Your morning tour includes round-trip transportation, a professional guide, a light snack and hot chocolate.



Once back at the hotel, the rest of the day is at leisure – perhaps enjoy some of the amenities of this stunning hotel.
