

Highlights of Bali Island

The Island of Bali, known to many as a popular beach destination, a yogi's, surfer's, or diver's paradise, also offers a lot more to be discovered. Here are some of the highlights:

Ubud Monkey Forest

Mandala Suci Wenara Wana, better known as Ubud Monkey Forest, is the sanctuary and natural habitat of thousands of Balinese long-tailed monkeys.

Mount Batur

Mount Batur, 1.717m, is an active volcano located at the center of two concentric calderas north-west of Mount Agung. The first documented eruption was in 1804 and the most recent was in 2000.

Bicycle ride in Bali's south side

Explore remote villages and observe the local way of life.

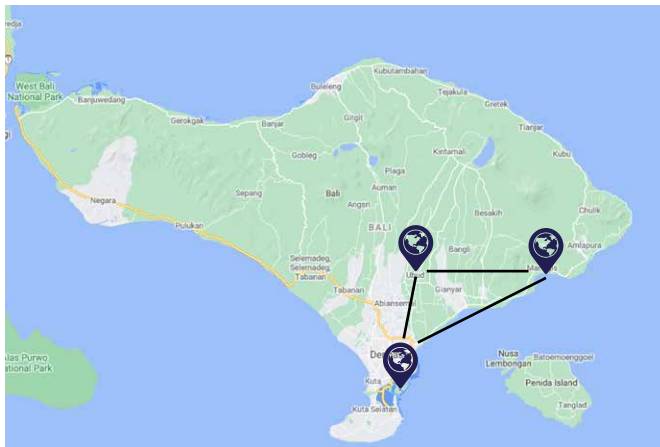

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Day 1: Bali arrival – Ubud

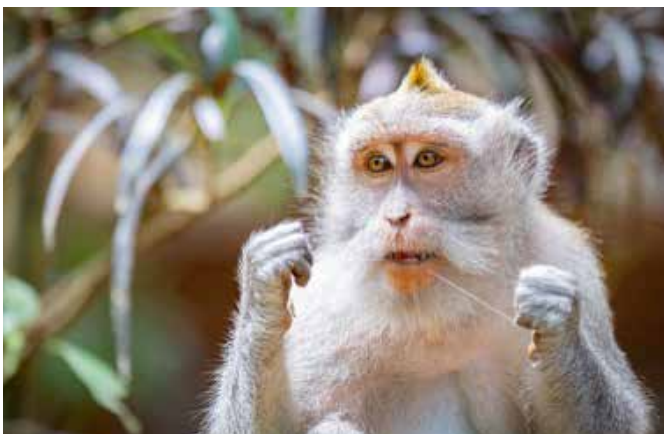
Arrive in Bali. Upon clearing Customs and Immigration, your guide will give you a welcome packet and transfer you to Ubud. Check-in to your hotel and the rest of the day will be at leisure.

Overnight in Ubud

Day 2: Ubud

Breakfast at the hotel. Meet your guide and start your visit to the beautiful and sacred Monkey Forest in Sangeh. The main attractions here are the hordes of funny yet wise Balinese monkeys inhabiting both the trees and the temple, Bukit Sari. Drive to Bedugul, a village in the central highlands famous for its stunning beauty and three lakes. Stroll around the traditional market where a myriad of fruits, vegetables, orchids, exotic spices and souvenirs are for sale. At the nearby Lake Bratan, admire the Ulun Danu temple, built on a small island in the serene lake.

Lunch in a local restaurant.



Drive south to the rice terraces of Jatiluwih, a famous UNESCO site. Trek through this area of terraced rice fields and learn about the Subak irrigation system that has been preserved by the Balinese farmers for centuries.

Overnight in Ubud

Day 3: Ubud

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the holy springs temple, and meet genuine Balinese people.

Visit Tirta Empul Temple where the holy springs flow to Bali's rivers and fields, providing life to people and nature. Balinese Hindu worshipers have been drawn to this temple to bathe in its refreshing blessed water, and this tradition still continues today.

The next visit is with the descendants of artist Mr Ida Bagus Grebuak, whose paintings have been exhibited in the Netherlands. These artistic skills have been passed down through the three surviving generations. Meet the family in their home and have a chat about how they pass on the skill to the children of the village.

Drive to a workshop where exquisite gold and silver designs are being created. At the end, enjoy walking along the rice fields before reaching the venue for lunch, at a garden with views of a rice field.

Overnight in Ubud

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Day 4: Ubud

Breakfast at the hotel. The whole day is free to discover the local artists, enjoy a nature walk, or indulge in a spa session.

Overnight in Ubud

Day 5: Ubud - Candidasa

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you leave Ubud and drive by Tegallalang famous for its terraced rice fields, plantations and souvenir shops. Once you approach the Batur area, enjoy stunning views of Mount Batur. On one side are the blue waters of Bali's largest lake, Lake Batur, and on the other are lava fields and cultivated patches. Next, visit Penglipuran village, a cool and well-preserved village surrounded by bamboo forest.

Lunch at a local restaurant.

Driving down to Candidasa, make a stop at a local plantation to see coffee and herbs, and taste the original Balinese coffee. After that, proceed to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free to explore on your own.

Overnight in Candidasa

Day 6: Candidasa

Breakfast at the hotel. Head out for a half-day tour to visit Ujung Water Palace, built by the king of Karangasem in 1919. Continue to Tirtagangga Water Fountain, a site of worship for the Hindu Balinese. Tirtagangga is a maze of pools and fountains surrounded by a lush garden, stone carvings and statues. The centrepiece is an eleven tiered fountain.

Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to your hotel and the remainder of the day is free.

Overnight in Candidasa

Day 7: Candidasa

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a full day free to explore at leisure

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Day 8: Candidasa – Tanjung Benoa (Nusa Dua)

Breakfast at the hotel. After check-out, meet your guide and transfer to the beach resort area of Tanjung Benoa/ Nusa Dua. Enjoy the rest of the day taking in the sun or enjoying the beach.

Overnight in Tanjung Benoa

Day 9: Tanjung Benoa

Breakfast at the hotel. Today visit a remote village and see the life of the locals as they meet at a traditional market offering daily local produce like vegetables, cooking oil, snacks, and the offerings. Driving slowly on bicycle (option by car), visit an expert on wooden-temple making, a skill that is passed on from generations. Also pay a visit to see the stone-carvers. At a local home, watch the mother making traditional crispy cookies, made daily and delivered to the market for selling. In the backyard, watch the process of getting milk from a tree which is called “tuak”, a natural and traditional drink.

Continue on foot and visit another house where lunch will be served, followed by a demo of Balinese dessert-making.

After lunch, continue your trip to visit Tanah Lot Temple, a famous site and most photographed temple in Bali. Return to your hotel and enjoy the rest of day at leisure.

Overnight in Tanjung Benoa

Day 10: Tanjung Benoa

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning at leisure to relax and enjoy the hotel facilities.

In the afternoon, depart to visit the highest monument in Bali, the Garuda Wisnu Kencana statue. Located in a huge area, the GWK Park also has an amphitheater offering daily performances. After a short drive, visit Uluwatu Temple, one of the most-holiest temples in Bali, surrounded by a monkey forest. After sunset, drive down to Jimbaran and enjoy a seafood dinner on the beach. Return to your hotel.

Overnight in Tanjung Benoa



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Day 11: Tanjung Benoa

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day is at leisure. Enjoy your last day in Bali.

Day 12: Bali

Breakfast at the hotel. After check-out, meet your guide and transfer to Denpasar Airport.
