Day 1: Vancouver

After making your own way to the Fairmont Vancouver, check-in to the hotel with the rest of the day at leisure

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

Day 2: Vancouver

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy the day to discover this lovely city. Perhaps visit well known Stanley Park with its oceanside seawall walk or travel up to Grouse Mountain for a bird's eye view of the whole city. Check out Robson Street with its many restaurants for a great dinner. (B)

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

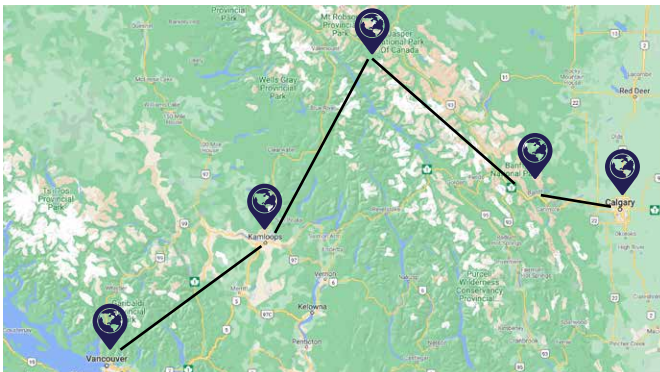
Day 3: Vancouver – Kamloops / Rocky Mountaineer

Your Rocky Mountaineer transfer team will pick you up in time to board the train for the 8am departure from



its downtown Vancouver Rail Station. After check-in procedures are complete, settle into your seat and enjoy the scenery. On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops. You will be transferred to the hotel shown on the boarding pass you received when you first joined the train. (B/L)

Overnight: Kamloops (hotel booked by Rocky Mountaineer)



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Day 4: Kamloops – Jasper / Rocky Mountaineer

Your journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, Pyramid Falls, and the climb over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Arrival in Jasper between 7:30pm- 9:00pm and transfer to the hotel. (B/L)

Overnight: Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge – Fairmont Room



Day 5: Jasper – Banff

After breakfast, your bus departs at 8:30am for Banff. Stop along the way for visits and lunch (not applicable for April departure). Arrive in Banff in the early afternoon. After checking into the hotel, you have the rest of the day at leisure. (B/L)

Overnight: Banff Caribou Lodge – Standard Room

Day 6: Banff

Breakfast at hotel. Full day at leisure to explore the small town of Banff. Walk and cycle the convenient roads and trails that lead to most amenities and attractions or use Roam, Banff's public transit system. The lively streets of downtown are lined with top-class restaurants, bars, and shops, as well as a vibrant range of art galleries and museums. (B)

Overnight: Banff Caribou Lodge – Standard Room

Day 7: Banff – Calgary departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Your bus departs Banff at 2pm. Depending on your travel plans, the bus takes about 2 hours to Calgary Airport or 3 hours to downtown Calgary. (B)
