Day 1: Calgary - Banff

After collecting your luggage, proceed to the Pursuit Transportation Desk in the airport arrivals area for your transfer to Banff. Check-in to the hotel with the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Banff Caribou Lodge – Standard Room

Day 2: Banff

After breakfast, you have the day at leisure to explore. The Banff town site is small, which means it's easy to get around and accessible for everyone. Walk and cycle the convenient roads and trails that lead to most amenities and attractions or use Roam, Banff's public transit system. The lively streets of downtown are lined with top-class restaurants, bars, and shops, as well as a vibrant range of art galleries and museums. (B)

Day 3: Banff - Jasper

Breakfast at the hotel. Your bus transfer departs about 8:30am to Jasper. Stop en route for visits and lunch (not applicable for April departure). Arrive in Jasper around 12:45pm. After checking into the hotel, the rest of the day is at leisure. One of the must do things in Jasper is the Jasper Tram which is the longest and highest guided aerial tramway in Canada and provides stunning views of six mountain ranges, glacially fed lakes, rivers and of course the mountain town of Jasper. (B/L)

Overnight: Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge - Fairmont Room

Day 4: Jasper – Kamloops / Rocky Mountaineer

Transfer to the Jasper Rail Station to board the Rocky Mountaineer at 8:30am. Your journey travels south and west towards the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of BC. From Jasper National Park you climb over the Yellowhead Pass. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Rockies soaring to 12,972 feet. Pass through the Cariboo and Monashee mountains as you follow the North Thompson River and into Kamloops. Once you've arrived at the Kamloops Rail Station you will be transferred to your hotel. (B/L)

Overnight: Kamloops (hotel booked by Rocky Mountaineer)



Day 5: Kamloops – Vancouver / Rocky Mountaineer

Your journey continues west towards the Pacific Ocean and the coastal city of Vancouver. On today's journey you will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the Interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade Mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. After collecting your luggage, you will be transferred to your hotel for the night. (B/L)

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

Day 6: Vancouver

After breakfast, you have the day at leisure. Perhaps visit well known Stanley Park with its oceanside seawall walk or travel up to Grouse Mountain for a bird's eye view of the whole city. Check out Robson Street with its many restaurants for a great dinner. (B)

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

After breakfast, your journey through B.C. and into Alberta ends. (B)
