Day 1: Vancouver

After making your own way to the Fairmont Vancouver, check-in to the hotel with the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy the day to explore this lovely city. Perhaps visit well known Stanley Park with its oceanside seawall walk or travel up to Grouse Mountain for a bird's eye view of the whole city. Check out Robson Street with its many restaurants for a great dinner. (B)

Overnight: Fairmont Vancouver – Fairmont Room

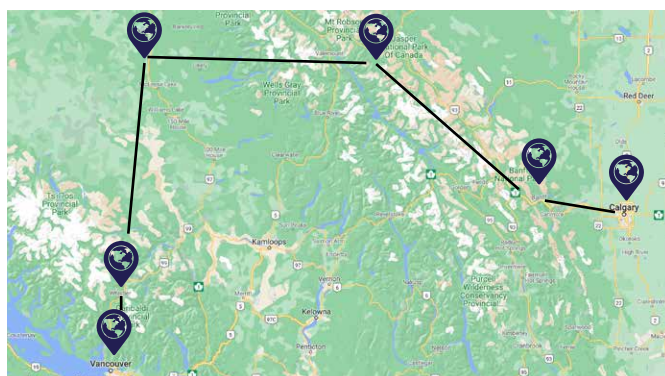


Day 3: Vancouver – Whistler / Rocky Mountaineer

Following your check-in, hotel assignment and motorcoach transfer from your downtown Vancouver hotel, the Rocky Mountaineer takes you on a breathtaking rail journey through the stunning scenery of the Sea to Sky Corridor. Highlights of the trip include spectacular views of Howe Sound and the Coast Mountains, Brandywine Falls, Mount Garibaldi, and the impressive Cheakamus Canyon. Breakfast will be served onboard. You will arrive in Whistler between 11:30am and 12:30pm. There is lots of time for you to wander around Whistler Village - from the cultural to the culinary, the educational to the entertaining, its boutique shops, museums, restaurants, galleries, events, and festivals Whistler delivers countless options for all.

Perhaps treat yourself to a ride on the Whistler Gondola for incomparable views of towering volcanic peaks, coastal rainforest, and ancient glaciers (B)

Overnight: Whistler (hotel booked by Rocky Mountaineer)



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Day 4: Whistler – Quesnel / Rocky Mountaineer

After a short bus transfer from Whistler, you will board the Rocky Mountaineer train at the Pemberton Station at 7:10am and travel to the charming rural town of Quesnel, gateway to the North Cariboo. Enjoy breathtaking and varied scenery, from the river canyons and lush farmland of the Pemberton Valley, through the desert-like conditions of the Fraser Canyon, to rolling hills and vast ranch lands of the Cariboo Plateau. Highlights include the shorelines of Anderson Lake and glacier-fed Seton Lake, sweeping views of the Fraser Canyon, and the crossing of Deep Creek Bridge, one of the highest railway bridges in the world. Breakfast and lunch will be served onboard. Arrive in Quesnel between 8:00pm and 9:30pm. Spend the evening exploring the town or relaxing in your hotel. (B/L)

Overnight: Quesnel (hotel booked by Rocky Mountaineer)

Day 5: Quesnel – Jasper / Rocky Mountaineer

Your journey continues eastwards to the majestic Canadian Rockies and Jasper National Park. From Quesnel the Rocky Mountaineer follows the Fraser River north to the town of Prince George, then travels east through the forests of northern British



Columbia, home to plentiful wildlife, including a large population of moose. Entering the Rocky Mountain Trench, you are surrounded to the north by the steeply rising Rocky Mountains and to the south by the Cariboo Mountains. Continue climbing past Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, and through the Yellowhead Pass into the province of Alberta. After collecting your luggage, you will be transferred to your hotel for the night. (B/L/D)

Overnight: Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge – Fairmont Room

Day 6: Jasper – Banff

After breakfast, your bus departs at 8:30am and stops for visits and lunch along the way. Arrive in Banff in the early afternoon. After checking into the hotel, you have the rest of the day at leisure (B).

Overnight: Banff Caribou Lodge – Standard Room

Day 7: Banff

Breakfast at hotel. Full day at leisure to explore the small town of Banff. Walk and cycle the convenient roads and trails that lead to most amenities and attractions or use Roam, Banff's public transit system. The lively streets of downtown are lined with top-class restaurants, bars, and shops, as well as a vibrant range of art galleries and museums. (B)

Overnight: Banff Caribou Lodge – Standard Room

Day 8: Banff – Calgary departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Your bus departs Banff at 2pm. Depending on your travel plans, the bus takes about 2 hours to Calgary Airport or 3 hours to downtown Calgary. (B)
