## Day 1 : Arrive Delhi

Upon arrival at Delhi International Airport, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Evening at leisure.

## Day 2 : Delhi

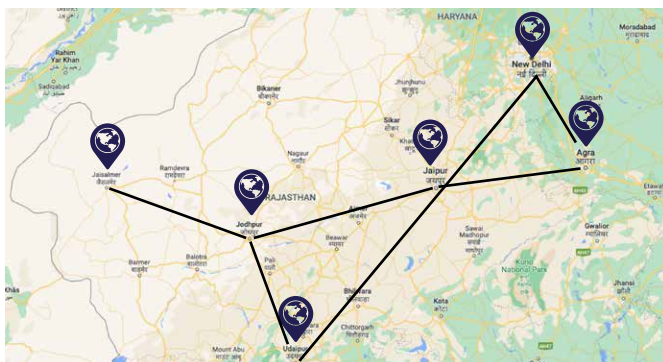
After breakfast proceed for sightseeing of Old and New Delhi. Guided tour of Old Delhi starting with Raj Ghat, where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated. Visit the largest mosque in India known as Jama Masjid. Take a rickshaw ride in narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk, old bazaar



of Delhi. From here you head to Red Fort (*Closed on Mondays*), built by emperor Shah Jahan in 17th century & labeled by UNESCO as a world heritage site.

Continue to pass India Gate, a memorial built in the year 1931 to commemorate the Indian soldiers who died in World War I & the Afghan Wars. President's House, the official residence of the President of India, built in the year 1931. Until 1950 it was known as Viceroy's House & served as the residence of the Governor- General of British India. Also visit Humayun's Tomb, memorial of Mughal Emperor Humayun, built in the year 1562. The complex is a World Heritage Site & the first example of this type of Mughal architecture in India. Qutub Minar, built in 1206, is the tallest (72m) brick minaret in the world, an important example of Indo-Islamic Architecture. Qutub Minar & its monuments are listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

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### Day 3 : Delhi – Agra (220kms/4hrs)

After breakfast drive to Agra. Visit the Taj Mahal (*Closed on Fridays*) – the symbol of eternal love, which stands on the banks of River Yamuna. It was built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in the year 1631 in memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal. It was completed in 22 years. Later visit Agra Fort. The Fort can be more accurately described as a walled palatial city. It was built from red sandstone, often inlaid with white marble & intricate decorations. Upon completion check into your hotel. Evening at leisure.

### Day 4 : Agra – Fatehpur Sikri - Jaipur (242kms/6hrs)

After breakfast drive to Jaipur and enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri, the political capital of India's Mughal Empire under Akbar's reign, from the year 1571 until 1585 and later abandoned due to lack of water. Later continue to Jaipur. Jaipur city was founded in the year 1728. It remains the only city in the world symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe, through nine rectangular sectors. Arrive and check into your hotel. Evening at leisure.

### Day 5 : Jaipur

After an early breakfast you will be taken to Amber Fort. The majestic fort located at the top of Aravali Hills built during the reign of Raja Man Singh. Take a short ride on elephant's back to reach the fort. Later visit The City Palace - a perfection of Rajput & Mughal architecture. The center of the palace is a

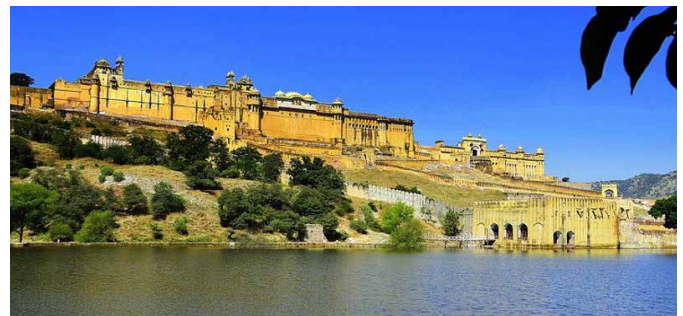
seven-storied building called Chandra Palace, with fine views over the gardens and the city. Further on, visit Jantar Mantar (Solar Observatory), an astronomical treasure house, with solar devices that give accurate predictions till date. You will also visit Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), a five-storied structure of pink sandstone. It was built in the year 1799 so that veiled royal women could peer down the busy street market unseen by the world through its 593 stone Jharokas (Mini Windows). Evening free for shopping.

### Day 6 : Jaipur – Jodhpur (352kms/6.5hrs)

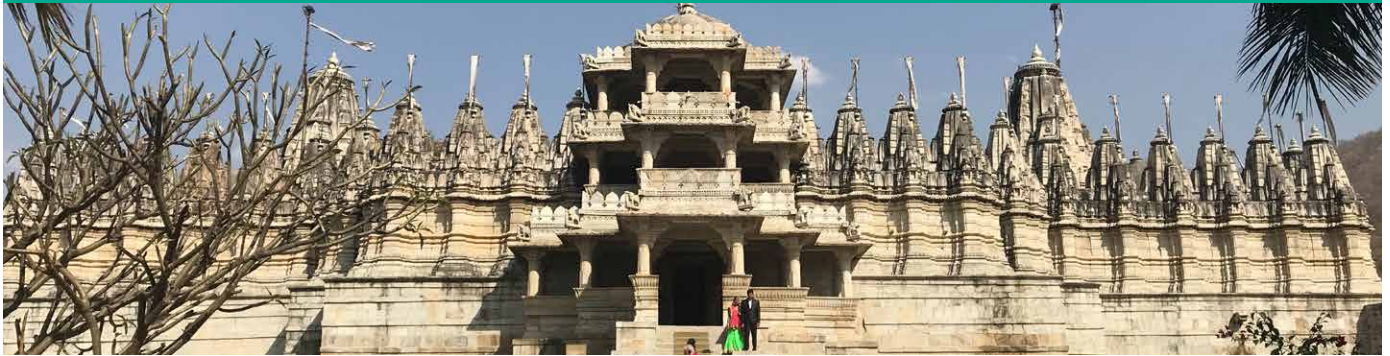
After breakfast drive to Jodhpur. Arrive and visit Mehrangarh Fort – which stands four hundred feet above the skyline of Jodhpur. The fort is burnished in Red Sandstone and its colossal structure is impressive. Visit Moti Mahal – largest room in fort whose ceiling is decorated with Gold Leaves, Seashells and Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure dome of the Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative mirror palace with brightly colored paintings, Silah Khana – place where weapons were stored, Daulat Khana – treasure vault and Rang Mahal. Evening at leisure.

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### Day 7 : Jodhpur – Jaisalmer (281kms/6hrs)

Today you proceed to Jaisalmer – Golden City of the desert famed for its yellow sandstone architecture. Upon arrival take a blissful boat ride in Gadisar Lake surrounded by many temples, shrines, and Ghats. Later enjoy a delightful puppet show – a preserved ancient folk art of Rajasthan.

### Day 8 : Jaisalmer

After breakfast explore Jaisalmer City. Visit Golden Fort – a UNESCO world heritage site and one of the very few living forts in the world, as nearly one fourth the population of the city still resides within the Fort. Continue to visit Patwon ki Haweli Museum – a Palace built in early 1800s, now a museum featuring intricate carvings, furniture, and artwork. It's time to visit Kuldhara – an abandoned village believed to be cursed. Proceed to famous Sam Sand Dunes. Upon arrival experience thrilling Dune Bashing over the golden sands of Jaisalmer. In the evening enjoy a Camel Ride and view the Red Orange color splash of the sunset on the desert horizon.

### Day 9 : Jaisalmer – Jodhpur (281kms/6hrs)

After breakfast drive to Jodhpur. Arrive and explore Ummaid Bhavan Palace Museum showcasing artistic murals, opulent miniature paintings, vintage clocks, and unusual household paraphernalia. Later visit Jaswant Thada – a royal cenotaph built in the white marble also known as Taj Mahal of Marwar. You then see the Sanganer Block Prints Demonstration – a hand-block printing technique originating from Sanganer. In the evening free time for shopping.

### Day 10 : Jodhpur – Udaipur Enroute Ranakapur Jain Temples (250kms/6hrs)

After breakfast drive to Udaipur. Enroute visiting Ranakapur Jain Temples. Udaipur – former capital and crown jewel of Mewar Kingdom also famous as City of Lakes. Evening at leisure.

### Day 11 : Udaipur

Today you explore Udaipur City. Visit the historic site of Maharana Pratap Smarak – located on top of Moti Magri hill near Fateh Sagar Lake. Later you visit City Palace – an architectural marvel and largest royal palace complex in Rajasthan built on banks of Lake Pichola. Enjoy a boat ride to reach Jag Mandir – the palace built on an island in Lake Pichola used as a summer resort and pleasure palace for holding royal parties. In the evening enjoy a traditional music and dance show at Bagore ki Haweli.

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### Day 12 : Udaipur - Delhi By Flight

After breakfast transfer to Udaipur airport to board a flight for Delhi. Upon arrival in Delhi, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Evening at leisure or free for shopping.
