Day 1: Cape Town arrival – City Tour

Upon arrival to Cape Town International Airport, you will be met by our representative and depart for a city tour. Discover the depth of history as you drive past Parliament Buildings, City Hall, and the Slave Lodge before stopping for a short visit of the Castle of Good Hope (optional), originally built as a maritime replenishment station and now the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa! Alternatively, you can walk around the Grand Parade square. Listen to a brief history of District Six on-route to visit the Company Gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as you move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colors of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as



he creates every girl's dream stone with a visit to a diamond cutting factory. After learning more about the history of diamonds and gold in South Africa, drive past the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, Sea Point, Clifton, and Camps Bay, as you make your way to Table Mountain (weather permitting). Drop off at the hotel and check in.

Day 2 Cape Town – Peninsula Tour

After breakfast you will be met by your guide where you will journey along Millionaires Paradise, from Clifton to Camps Bay, to the exclusive beach hamlet of Llandudno – towards the charming working harbour of Hout Bay. Here, embark on an up-close-and-personal Seal Island cruise. After, drive along the legendary Chapman’s Peak Drive, hugging the cliffs and relishing in the breathtaking ocean views, before arriving at the lunch spot of choice at the Cape of Good Hope Section of the Table Mountain National Park. Meander back along the coast towards the city, visiting the historic naval port of Simon’s Town and the endearing penguin colony at Boulder’s Beach.

Day 3: Cape Town – Winelands Tour

After breakfast meet your guide for a tour of the Winelands, a region in the south of South Africa. The winelands boast some of the most majestic scenery in South Africa. It is situated to the north-east of Cape Town and offers a beautiful landscape of wine hills and mountains.

Day 4: Cape Town – Johannesburg

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the airport for your flight to Johannesburg. On arrival at OR Tambo International you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Day 5: Johannesburg – Soweto Tour

This morning, depart for a tour of Soweto, acronym for Southwestern Township, home to over 2 million people, who, despite living in crowded and chaotic conditions, have a tangible sense of community. Inside Soweto, visit the Kliptown Open Air Museum where delegates met in 1955 to adopt the Freedom Charter, now the cornerstone of the Bill of Rights and the South African Constitution. This journey continues to Regina Mundi Church, site of many secret underground meetings of the then banned political parties. The next stop is the Hector Pietersen Museum and discover the cause of the tragic riots which led to his death; guests will pass Mandela House and given time to visit this fascinating little museum. Finally, pass by the largest stadium in Africa, Soccer City, host of the 2010 FIFA World Cup Final. Soweto is unlike any suburb you’ve ever seen or been to, yet the history of struggle encapsulated here is a cornerstone of the South African Story.

Day 6: Johannesburg - Graskop (± 5hr)

After breakfast, depart by private vehicle and English guide to Graskop via the Panorama Route.

Graskop is a small town in Mpumalanga province, South Africa. It was set up in the 1880s as a gold mining camp, but it now serves as a tourist destination and the timber industry. "God's Window", a scenic view from the escarpment of the Lowveld below, is located outside the town.

Journey to the best of the best, visiting the legendary Blyde River Canyon, third largest in the world, and enjoy the never-ending Lowveld landscape from the ledge of God's Window. Visit the quaint, historical mining town of Pilgrim's Rest, for a lunch stop (own account). After lunch time to explore some more of this Panorama route. On-route to Hazyview, time and weather permitting, opportunity to experience the Graskop Gorge lift (own account) which will take you 51 meters down along a cliff face into the mountain forest below. Once at the bottom, a wooden walkway, rising and falling and crossing suspension bridges, will take guests along a 600-metre interpretation trail through the indigenous forest. From canyons to potholes, Mpumalanga's a province of many splendid things.

Overnight in Graskop

Day 7: Graskop – Karongwe Private Game Reserve (± 2hr)

After breakfast, check out and transfer to Karongwe Private Game Reserve. The guide will drop you off and return to Johannesburg.

Karongwe Private Game Reserve in Limpopo, South Africa, is a wildlife sanctuary located between 4 rivers which provides exceptional habitats for diverse flora, fauna, and prolific birdlife.

Highlights: Great Leopard viewing as well as the other Big Five.

Enjoy 2 days of safari.

Day 10: Karongwe – Johannesburg (± 5hr)

Enjoy a morning game drive before having breakfast and checking out. Pick up and transfer back to Johannesburg airport for your onward flight home.
