Day 1, Arrival in Edinburgh

Day 3, Edinburgh - Belfast

Day 4, Belfast

Stop off at Bushmills Distillery and visit the gift shop or take a quick trip to the bar to have a swift taste or two of the famous tipples, Irish whiskey!

2) Game of Thrones Filming Locations Tour (9 hrs.)

This is fully guided, all day tour taking in the best of the Game of Thrones filming locations on the beautiful North Antrim coast. Although there are seven designated stopping points, the tour also weaves past and takes in other well-known parts of Westeros.

Day 5, Belfast - Dublin
