
Day 1: Manila – arrival

Arrive at Manila's International Airport. Meet and greet and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: Manila city tour

City tour of Manila. First stop is Rizal Park named after their National Hero Dr. Jose Rizal. Next stop is the walled city of Old Intramuros, built by the Spaniards and home of the elite during the long period of Spanish colonization in the Philippines; The battle for liberation of Manila in 1945 World War II left the area in ruins.





Stop at San Agustin Church, the oldest stone church that withstood heavy bombardment during the 2nd World War. The tour continues to Fort Santiago, one of the oldest forts in Manila built in 1571. It was here that Dr. Jose Rizal spent his last days and where he wrote his famous "My Last Farewell". Guests will have a "kalesa ride" or a horse-carriage and witness the local community inside the walled-city. Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, proceed to American Cemetery, It contains the largest number of graves of their military dead of World War II, a total of 16,859, most of whom lost their lives in operations in New Guinea and the Philippines. Return to hotel.

Day 3: Manila / Boracay

Check-out and transfer to the airport for the flight to Boracay. Meet and greet at Boracay airport and transfer to the resort.

Take a 2-hour ferry on business class tickets going to the island of Bohol, famous for the "chocolate hills" and "Tarsier". Let your adrenaline rush be activated by having a zip-line experience. A delectable buffet lunch awaits on-board a floating restaurant cruising the Loboc river.

Day 9: Cebu

Depart on a city tour of Cebu through landmarks like Magellan's Cross and St. Nino Basilica. Appreciate the creative mix of foreign influences and local tradition in places like Casa Gorordo Museum, Fort San Pedro, and the colorful native market. Here, you will enjoy a 15-minute jeepney ride experience. Jeepney is the most popular mode of transportation in the country, it fits 15 - 20 passengers and is decorated with colorful hand-painting in the ceiling. Loud music keeps the passenger awake during rush hour traffic. A visit to a guitar factory is also a highlight.

Morning at leisure. Check out and meet your guide for a transfer to Mactan Cebu Airport. End of services.
