Day 2 - Lucerne-Interlaken Express & Excursion Jungfrauoch

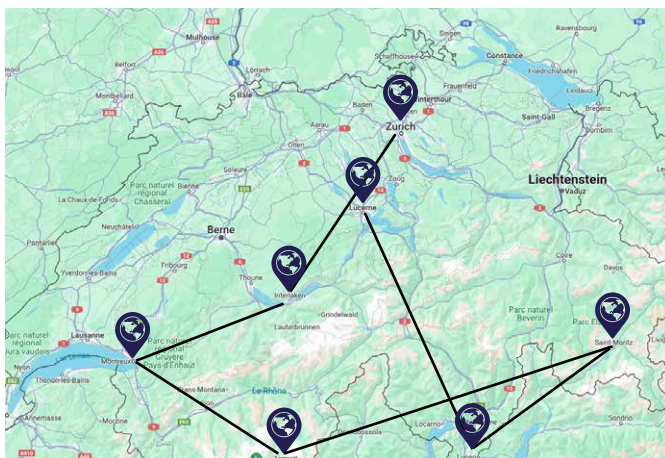

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover a world of breathtaking landscapes, charming villages, and alpine vistas on your journey along the GoldenPass Line to Montreux. Marvel at the scenery as your train climbs up the Simmental and down to the shores of Lake Geneva.

Day 4 - Montreux-Zermatt

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel from Montreux to Zermatt. Zermatt lies at the foot of the Matterhorn and offers plenty of things to explore. Enjoy a leisure day on your own and don't miss out an excursion to the Gornergrat (optional tour).

Day 5 - Glacier Express

Breakfast at the hotel. Take the world-famous Glacier Express to St. Moritz. Enjoy some of the spectacular scenery Switzerland has to offer. Along the deep Rhone valley, the Glacier Express travels through an incredibly fascinating part of the Alps.

Overnight in St. Moritz

Day 6 - Bernina Express

Breakfast at the hotel. Board the Bernina Express, travel over circular viaducts and pass through winding tunnels before reaching Tirano in Italy. Change to the Bernina Express bus which will take you onwards to Ticino.

Overnight in Lugano

Day 7 - Gotthard Panorama Express

Breakfast at the hotel. The Gotthard Panorama Express travels from the Mediterranean south to the traditional heart of Switzerland. From Flüelen you will have a boat ride over Lake Lucerne.

Overnight in Lucerne

Day 8 - Lucerne To Airport/Swiss Border

Breakfast at the hotel. Your journey comes to an end. Individual return journey to your ending point in Switzerland.
