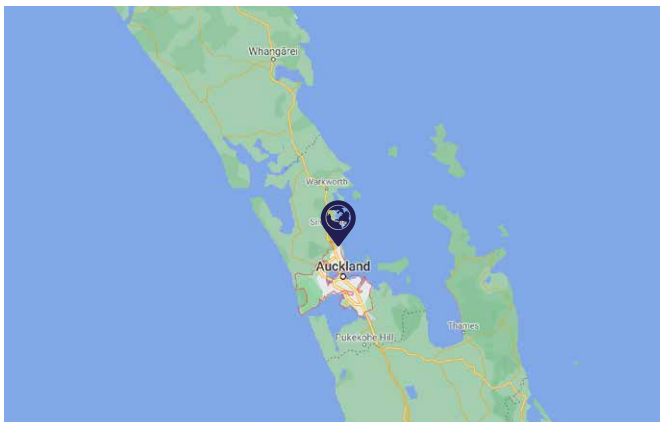

Add a sunny climate, a background rhythm of Polynesian culture and a passion for outstanding food, wine and shopping, and you're beginning to get the picture of Auckland, New Zealand, the country's largest and most diverse city.



Explore Auckland - 4 days / 3 nights



Day 1: Arrival Auckland

After clearing customs and collecting your luggage, you will find our transfer company in the outside arrivals area of Auckland Airport. Depending on your arrival time, check into your hotel. We suggest you take this first day to visit the Skytower for an overall visual of the city's layout. Admission to the Skytower/Skydeck is included in your package.

Overnight: 3.5* Chancellor on Hobson or 4* Rydges Auckland

Day 2: Auckland

This morning, enjoy a tour highlighting the city of Auckland, and take a journey to explore the history and sights and see how Aucklanders live and play. The small group tour gives an insight into the Māori history of the area and the legends and stories behind some of the place names.



Shortly after leaving the hotel, you travel up Queen St, through Auckland's central business district, past Auckland University and into the city park known as The Domain for a photo stop.

Continue through the picturesque suburb of Ponsonby, known for its historic buildings, before heading over the Harbour Bridge to the North Shore. Here you can stroll on a beautiful beach with views out across the Waitemata harbour to Rangitoto Island. There is also a small local cafe here if you want to try some local baking and coffee (own expense).

Next stop is historic Devonport to get to the panoramic views over Auckland that you can only get from Mount Victoria – often considered the best view of Auckland.

On the return you travel back over the Harbour Bridge to stop at Westhaven Marina, one of the largest marinas in the Southern Hemisphere with views through the yacht masts to the city skyline.

Day 3 : Auckland

Today is a day at leisure where you can explore on your own. You may want to get out onto the water with perhaps a cruise from Auckland Harbour to Waiheke Island for a wine tour or if movies interest you, there is a full day tour to the Hobbiton film location available.
