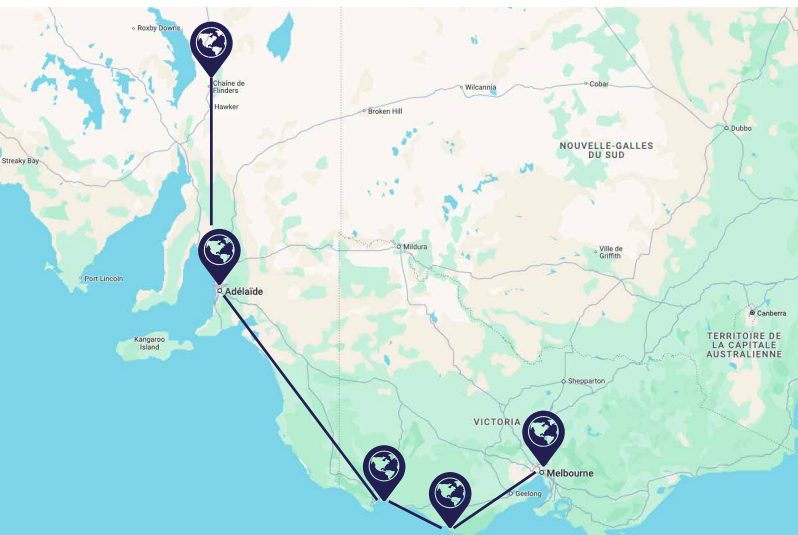

DAY 2 : MELBOURNE TOUR - LANES AND ARCADES TOUR WITH LUNCH

Full buffet breakfast RACV Cape Schanck Resort. Leisurely 90-minute drive to the Yarra valley. Visit four of the Yarra valley's best wineries. Wine tastings at all four wineries on offer. Enjoy lunch with a glass of wine. After lunch return to Melbourne. (B,L)

DAY 5 : MELBOURNE - PORT CAMPBELL

A colourful and lively seaside village, Port Campbell is just minutes from the iconic Twelve Apostles and home to restaurants, cafes and spectacular views. Stroll along the beach, visit bakeries selling homemade goodies, and explore the vibrant shops and galleries. Sheltered by cliffs and Norfolk pines, the town has the atmosphere of a haven on the edge of wild nature. Finish the day with a walk out to the Port Campbell Jetty and watch the waves crashing against the limestone cliffs. (L)

DAY 6 : PORT CAMPBELL - PORT FAIRY - 12 APOSTLES

Established as a whaling and sealing station in 1833, Port Fairy has retained its historic 19th-century maritime charm. With its abundance of Georgian style Bluestone and Sandstone merchants' homes, and restored quaint whitewashed cottages.

Visit the 12 Apostles and take in the view during the morning sunlight and/or take a helicopter flight (at own expense) over this amazing coastline. Spend time visiting the unique formations of Loch Ard Gorge and immerse ourselves in the harrowing story of the wreck of the Lock Ard. It's onto London Bridge and then The Bay of Islands before saying goodbye to this amazing stretch of coastline. (B,L)

DAY 7 : PORT FAIRY - NARACOOTE

Today you are bound for South Australia. In Portland there's time for panoramic coastal views from the Cape Nelson Lighthouse, before a scenic drive through dense pine plantations to our lunch venue in the pretty riverside village of Nelson.

After lunch, cross the state border and continue to Mount Gambier which is home to the famous Blue Lake which occupies a crater of the ancient volcano which gives this city its name and early each summer, in a remarkable quirk of nature, the colour of the water in the lake changes from its winter hues to an intense cobalt blue. A visit to the Umpherston Sinkhole, a collapsed limestone cave that has been transformed into a magical sunken garden. Take a walk along its terraced flower beds and behind the hanging vines deep down to the floor of this extraordinary natural wonder. (B,L)

DAY 8 : NARACOOTE - ADELAIDE

Your tour returns to Adelaide at 6pm. You will then be transferred from the drop-off point to your hotel.

DAY 9 : ADELAIDE - FLINDERS RANGES

Today, you will be picked up from the hotel to start your next adventure to the wonderful Flinders Ranges.

Be amazed by the beauty of the Southern Flinders Ranges, 600-million-year-old mountain peaks and spectacular views over Spencer Gulf. Travel through the picturesque Pichi Richi Pass to the historic township of Quorn. With its typical outback buildings and the original Ghan Railway station, Quorn has been the setting for many iconic Australian films.

Follow in the path of our early explorers driving to Warren Gorge Conservation Park to search for rare and elusive Yellow-Footed Rock Wallabies. Dramatic rock outcrops harbour these endangered wallabies with only an estimated 8,000 living in the wild. (L)

DAY 10 : FLINDERS RANGES TOURING

This morning after a hearty breakfast, our expert guide will drive you on a wonderful journey to the spectacular Bunyeroo Gorge, visiting secluded areas of great natural beauty. Explore the ever-changing creek beds of Brachina Gorge. This is an area alive with wildlife and boasts a remarkable geological history including Ediacaran fossils dating back millions of years.

After a picnic lunch, immerse yourself in the ancient landscape; take that special photograph from Razor Back Lookout or just enjoy some of the most spectacular outback scenery Australia has to offer. Wildlife including Kangaroos, Emus and Wedge tailed Eagles are prolific in this rugged terrain. (B,L)
