DAY 1: PORTO


Arrive at Porto airport and transfer to your hotel.


DAY 2 : PORTO, EMBARKATION

Transfer to the port and embark on your cruise on the AmaDouro.

DAY 3 : RÉGUA

This tranquil village offers an authentic experience of life on the Douro River. With your fellow Régua travelers, enjoy a traditional Portuguese lunch at a local quinta - a country estate - for a truly authentic culinary experience. In the afternoon, visit the Baroque-style Mateus Palace and its gardens. Inside the house, you'll see period furniture, paintings and a carved wooden ceiling. The gardens are considered one of the most beautiful in Portugal.

DAY 4: VEGA DE TERRÓN

In the morning, take time to soak up the beauty of this picturesque port before visiting Castelo Rodrigo, a small fortified village perched atop a hill, with centuries-old walls, steep narrow streets and fantastic views. You can also opt for a hike up to the village if you want a more active exploration.

DAY 5 : VEGA DE TERRÓN — SALAMANCA, SPAIN

Drive to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built of golden sandstone, Salamanca is known as a "living museum" and you'll have the chance to step back in time to the Middle Ages during your guided tour, which includes the city's elegant university buildings, the new cathedral, the intriguingly decorated shell house and the Plaza Mayor.

DAY 6 : PINHÃO

Spend some time soaking up the beauty of the Douro River on your cruise to Pinhão. Dine exclusively at Quinta da Avessada, where you'll enjoy an authentic and traditional gastronomic experience, complete with entertainment. Quinta da Avessada is also a fascinating interactive museum commemorating the history and culture of wine in the Upper Douro region. You'll have the pleasure of discovering all the stages of wine production, and enjoying a wide range of tastings. Savor the flavors of Portugal's famous fortified wine, vinho do porto, produced exclusively in the Douro Valley. Visit a local quinta for an authentic port wine tasting experience and savor the sweet nectar of this fascinating region.





DAY 7 : RÉGUA

Travel to picturesque Lamego, home to one of the most important pilgrimage sites in all of Portugal, where you'll make your way to the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios (Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies). The sanctuary features a staircase of almost 700 steps, beautifully decorated with white and blue tiles, which more active adventurers will want to climb on a guided hike. To round off both visits, you'll have the opportunity to sample traditional local specialties, such as bôlas de Lamego, a bread filled with smoked ham, presunto, a type of dry-cured ham, and Espumante, a Portuguese sparkling wine.

DAY 8: PORTO

The colorful city of Porto combines the best of the old and the new, which you can discover on a guided tour of the historic district, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which includes the cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments, and the São Bento train station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. You'll also enjoy a Porto tasting, Portugal's most famous contribution to the world of wine. If you prefer to be more active, you can take a guided hike, followed by a Port wine tasting. In the afternoon, you can explore the charms of Porto at your leisure.

DAY 9 : PORTO. DEPART

Disembark the ship and bid farewell to Portugal. Transfer to the Porto airport for your return flight.
