#### **DAY 1: ARRIVE IN BANGKOK**

Welcome to Bangkok. Meet and greet and private transfer to your hotel. Free time to settle in and relax.

#### DAY 2 : BANGKOK

This morning, visit two of Bangkok's most important sites: the Wat Pho Reclining Buddha is a gigantic reclining Buddha, covered in gold leaf. The Grand Palace is a mustsee and a perfect example of an ancient Siamese court. Within the palace grounds is the Temple of the Emerald Buddha (Wat Pra Kaew). After lunch, return to the hotel. At the end of the day, discover the local market in the lively China Town district and the flower market, best explored on an overnight walking tour. Here you'll find street markets, restaurants, boutiques, gold stores, magnificent remnants of colonial architecture and some interesting Chinese temples, such as the Leng Noi Yee. China Town is also famous for its many varieties of food, and transforms into Bangkok's largest open-air restaurant at night. Near Chinatown, visit the city's largest flower market. (B/L)

Transfer to Bangkok airport for your flight to Chiang Rai. On arrival, welcome and transfer to your hotel. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

## **DAY 4: CHIANG RAI**

Early departure for a full day tour. Your first stop is the stunning White Temple (Wat Rong Khun) in Chiang Rai—an architectural marvel that's truly one of a kind. This dazzling white structure is inlaid with mirrored glass that sparkles in the sunlight. It's no surprise this is one of the most visited sites in Chiang Rai.

Next, head to the vibrant Blue Temple (Wat Rong Suea Ten), famous for its deep blue interiors and striking artwork. Enjoy lunch en route at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the historic Golden Triangle, the unique meeting point of Thailand, Laos, and Myanmar—a region rich in cultural and political history.

Then, enjoy a scenic long-tail boat ride along the Mekong River, giving you the chance to cross into Laos and explore its riverside markets (passport may be required). To end the day, visit the House of Opium Museum, offering insight into the area's complex past linked to the opium trade.

#### **DAY 6: CHIANG MAI**

This morning, set off to visit the Elephant Jungle Sanctuary, one of the best elephant sanctuaries for sustainable and ethical treatment. The elephant sanctuary offers many opportunities for visitors to discover Thailand's wonderful elephants. Qualified English-speaking guides give an insight into the behavior and personal history of the elephants. Elephant mahouts help participants enjoy incredible experiences, such as hand-feeding and bathing elephants in Chiang Mai. Lunch is included, and the afternoon is free to relax. In the evening, dinner is served in a local restaurant. (B/L/D)

# **DAY 7: CHIANG MAI | PHUKET**

Transfer to Chiang Mai airportfor your flight to Phuket. On arrival, welcome and transfer to hotel. (B)

#### **DAY 8: PHUKET**

Depart for the visit to the Phi Phi Islands and Bamboo Island by boat (shared basis). Admire the rock formations surrounded by jungle and the turquoise waters of the Phi Phi archipelago during an unforgettable speedboat experience. Spend the day sunbathing, swimming, and snorkeling in some of Thailand's most postcard-worthy destinations, including stunning coral reefs, the unique lagoon of Pileh, the white sandy beaches of Bamboo Island, and the emerald waters of Maya Beach, immortalized in the film "The Beach" starring Leonardo DiCaprio. Lunch included. Return to Phuket late afternoon. (B/L)

#### DAY 13 : PHUKET | BANGKOK

Transfer to Phuket airport for your flight to Bangkok. Welcome on arrival and depart for a boath tour of the Klongs of Bangkok. The klongs are traditional canals running through the city, offering a unique perspective on the daily life and history of Thailand's capital. Visit Jim Thompson House, accessible from the klongs. It is dedicated to the American entrepreneur who helped revitalize Thailand's silk industry. From the klongs, you'll also see the Houses on Stilts, traditional Thai houses built on stilts along the klongs, offering a glimpse of local architecture. Lunch at a local restaurant. Next, a visit to Wat Saket, also known as the Golden Mount, one of Bangkok's most famous temples. Check in to your hotel. (B/L)

## DAY 14 : BANGKOK | RIVER KWAI | BANGKOK

Departure for Kanchanaburi province. Visit the military cemetery, the famous bridge over the River Kwai and a train ride along the "Death Railway", as well as a boat trip on the River Kwai. Lunch in a local restaurant. Return to Bangkok in the late afternoon. (B/L)

## **DAY 15: BANGKOK**

This morning, depart for the famous Damnoen Saduak floating market, located 100 kilometers from the city center. Start with a scenic ride on a narrow, long-tailed boat, past riverside villages and fruit plantations, before entering the bustling market. Lunch in a local restaurant. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon. (B/L)
