Immerse yourself in the beauty of iconic sites like the Table Mountain, the Cape Peninsula, the Winelands, and the powerful legacy of Soweto. Experience the thrill of a safari at Karongwe Private Game Reserve, where you'll encounter Africa's Big Five in their natural habitat.



DAY 1 : CAPE TOWN ARRIVAL - CITY TOUR

Arrive at Cape Town International Airport. Meet and greet and embark on a city tour. Drive past Parliament, City Hall, and the Slave Lodge before a brief visit to the Castle of Good Hope (optional) or a stroll around Grand Parade Square. Learn about District Six and visit the Company Gardens. Explore the Bo-Kaap with its colorful homes and rich history. Visit a diamond cutting factory, then pass the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, and scenic beaches on your way to Table Mountain (weather permitting). End with hotel drop-off and check-in.

Night in Cape Town: SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 4* or similar



DAY 2 : CAPE TOWN - PENINSULA TOUR

This morning, meet your guide and begin your journey along Millionaire's Paradise, from Clifton to Camps Bay, and then to the exclusive beach hamlet of Llandudno, before continuing towards the charming working harbor of Hout Bay. Embark on a close-up Seal Island cruise, then drive along the scenic Chapman's Peak Drive, enjoying breathtaking ocean views. Stop for lunch within the Cape of Good Hope Section of Table Mountain National Park. Afterward, meander back along the coast towards the city, visiting the historic naval port of Simon's Town and the delightful penguin colony at Boulder's Beach.

Night in Cape Town: SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 4* or similar

DAY 3: CAPE TOWN - WINELANDS TOUR

Meet your guide for a tour of the Winelands, a stunning region in the south of South Africa. The Winelands are renowned for their majestic scenery, located to the northeast of Cape Town, offering a breathtaking landscape of rolling vineyards and dramatic mountains.

DAY 4 : CAPE TOWN - JOHANNESBURG (BY AIR)

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to the airport for the flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival at OR Tambo International, you'll be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Night in Johannesburg: Lucky Bean Guest House 3*+ or similar

DAY 5 : JOHANNESBURG - SOWETO TOUR

After breakfast depart for a tour of Soweto, home to over 2 million people who, despite difficult living conditions, share a strong sense of community. Visit the Kliptown Open Air Museum, where the Freedom Charter was adopted in 1955, laying the foundation for South Africa's Constitution. Continue to Regina Mundi Church, a hub for secret political meetings, then head to the Hector Pietersen Museum to learn about the tragic riots leading to his death. Pass Mandela House, with time for a visit, before stopping at Soccer City, Africa's largest stadium and host of the 2010 FIFA World Cup Final. Soweto offers a unique and powerful glimpse into South Africa's history of struggle.

Night in Johannesburg: Lucky Bean Guest House 3*+ or similar





DAY 6 : JOHANNESBURG - GRASKOP (± 5HR)

Depart by private vehicle and guide to Graskop via the Panorama Route. Graskop, a small town in Mpumalanga province, was established in the 1880s as a gold mining camp and now serves as both a tourist destination and a hub for the timber industry. Just outside the town, you'll find "God's Window," a scenic viewpoint from the escarpment overlooking the Lowveld below. Continue your journey to the legendary Blyde River Canyon, the third-largest canyon in the world, and enjoy sweeping views of the endless Lowveld landscape from the ledge of God's Window. Next, visit the historic mining town of Pilgrim's Rest for a lunch stop (own account). After lunch, time to explore more of the Panorama Route. En route to Hazyview, time and weather permitting, opportunity to experience the Graskop Gorge Lift (own account). This lift takes you 51 meters down a cliff face into the mountain forest below, where a wooden walkway, rising and falling and crossing suspension bridges, leads you along a 600meter interpretive trail through the indigenous forest. From canyons to potholes, Mpumalanga is a province full of natural wonders.

Night in Graskop: Iketla Lodge 4* or similar



DAY 7 : GRASKOP - KARONGWE PRIVATE RESEVE (2) HR)

After breakfast, checkout and transfer to Karongwe Private Game Reserve. The guide will drop you off and return to Johannesburg, Karongwe Private Game Reserve in Limpopo, South Africa, is a wildlife sanctuary located between 4 rivers which provides exceptional habitats for diverse flora, fauna, and prolific birdlife. Highlights: Great Leopard viewing as well as the other Big Five.

Night at the reserve: Karongwe Shiduli Private Game Lodge 4* (Luxury Suite) or similar

DAY 8 & 9 : KARONGWE PRIVATE RESERVE

Enjoy 2 days of safari.

Stay at the reserve: Karongwe Shiduli Private Game Lodge 4* (Luxury Suite) or similar

DAY 10: KARONGWE - JOHANNESBURG -DEPART(5 HR)

Enjoy a morning game drive before having breakfast and checking out. Pick up and transfer by shuttle to Johannesburg airport OR Tambo for your onward flight home.

- 3 nights at Shiduli Private Game Lodge 4* (Luxury Suite). All meals, teas, coffees, and snacks; Dawn and dusk safaris in open game drive vehicles; Drinks on dusk safaris are limited to one per person with a choice of local beer, wine, or soft drink; Reserve fees are all included
- Shuttle transfer from Karongwe Game Reserve to OR Tambo International Airport
