ARCTIC OCEAN & DEMPSTER HIGHWAY NORTH

Yukon & Northwest Territories

The ultimate northern road trip. This week-long adventure takes you to Whitehorse, Yukon's capital, and on to Dawson City, the historic gold rush town. Explore its streets, dance halls, and restaurants before heading north on the Dempster Highway. The route leads through the Tombstone Mountains to Eagle Plains, where you spend the night under the midnight sun. The next day, you cross the Arctic Circle before continuing across tundra, over the Richardson Mountains, and into the Northwest Territories. After crossing several major rivers, you arrive in Inuvik, located on the edge of the Mackenzie River Delta. A day trip follows to Tuktoyaktuk via the new highway, reaching the Arctic coast. The journey passes through mountains, tundra, and remote river crossings to the end of this iconic gravel road. Travelers from around the world come to drive the Dempster Highway and reach the Arctic Ocean—it remains a true northern milestone.



DAY 1: ARRIVE IN WHITEHORSE


Welcome to Canada's Yukon Territory. Your guide meets you at the airport and transfers you to your hotel, where you meet your fellow travelers. A short orientation follows.

Night in Whitehorse

DAY 2: WHITEHORSE - DAWSON CITY

Today, travel north along the Klondike Highway to Dawson City, the historic center of the Klondike Gold Rush. The route follows the Yukon River, one of North America's longest waterways, with stops at Five Finger Rapids and several historic roadhouses and settlements.

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DAY 3: DAWSON CITY

Once the center of the 1898 Klondike Gold Rush, Dawson City remains closely tied to its gold-mining past. Explore the town's history with visits to Bonanza Creek, the Jack London Cabin, the Dawson City Museum, and the Midnight Dome. Spend time wandering the streets before an evening of entertainment at Diamond Tooth Gertie's Gambling Hall.

Night in Dawson City

DAY 4: DAWSON CITY - EAGLE PLAINS

Today, the journey begins on the Dempster Highway, the only road link to Inuvik. The 730-kilometer gravel route crosses tundra and passes through Tombstone Territorial Park. The day ends at Eagle Plains.

Night in Eagle Plains

DAY 5: EAGLE PLAINS - INUVIK

Cross the Arctic Circle early in the day before continuing over the Richardson Mountains and into Arctic tundra. Pass through the communities of Fort McPherson and Tsuigehtchic before reaching Inuvik, the regional hub of the western Arctic. Inuvik serves as a base for exploring the Arctic coast.

Night in Inuvik

DAY 6: INUVIK - TUKTOYAKTUK - INUVIK

Today, travel north on the new road to Tuktoyaktuk, an isolated coastal village. Explore the town, see the pingos rising from the tundra, and learn about local First Nations history. Discover what a pingo and muktuk are during your visit.

Nights in Inuvik

DAY 7: INUVIK - WHITEHORSE BY AIR, END

There's just enough time to pay a visit to the Igloo Church this morning before you board the plane back to Whitehorse. End of tour services.
