



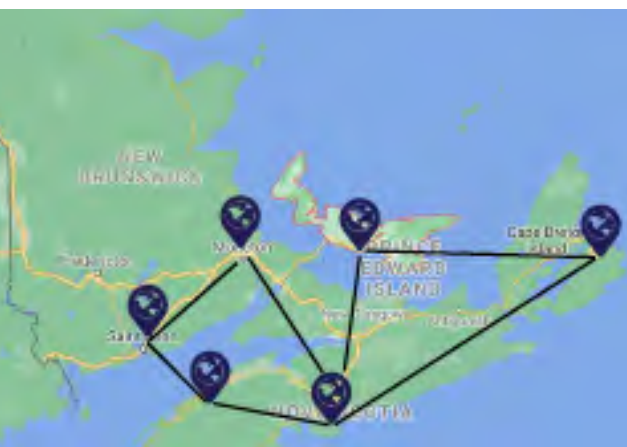

DAY 1: ARRIVAL HALIFAX, NS (TUESDAY)

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DAY 2 : HALIFAX - MONCTON

Explore the Bay of Fundy and learn about the world's highest tides as you meander along its colourful coastline en route to New Brunswick. Along the way, visit the Joggins Fossil Cliffs, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where exposed rock layers reveal the world's most complete fossil record from the "Coal Age," dating back 300 million years. After crossing into New Brunswick, an unforgettable culinary experience awaits as you enjoy a lobster dinner aboard a lobster boat.* Continue on to Moncton and check into your downtown hotel for the night. (Continental Breakfast, Lunch, Lobster Dinner)

DAY 3 : MONCTON - SAINT-JOHN, NB

Experience a true natural wonder this morning at the Hopewell Rocks along the coast of the Bay of Fundy. Marvel at the massive, flowerpot-shaped formations sculpted by the highest tides on the planet. Continue through Fundy National Park en route to Canada's first incorporated city, Saint John, located on the southern coast of New Brunswick. Enjoy a guided city tour, including a visit to the famous Reversing Falls, where twice daily the powerful tides of the Bay of Fundy force the Saint John River to reverse its flow. Check into your Saint John accommodations for a two-night stay. (Breakfast, Lunch)

DAY 4 : ST. ANDREWS BY-THE-SEA DAY TRIP

Enjoy a day trip to picturesque St. Andrews by-the-Sea, where the quaint charm of this coastal town is sure to captivate. After a whale-watching boat tour (weather permitting), the afternoon is yours to explore at leisure—discover the friendly people, beautiful architecture, and rich marine life that make this seaside gem so special. (Breakfast, Lunch)

DAY 5 : SAINT-JOHN, NB TO DIGBY, NS

Ferry back to Nova Scotia this morning, arriving in Digby, the scallop capital of the world, where fresh sea air and vibrant Acadian culture create an enchanting and historically rich town. Check into your hotel in Digby. (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 6 : DIGBY - HALIFAX, NS

Travel through the lush Annapolis Valley, where the French Acadians of Grand Pré established their first settlement in the early 1600s. Learn about the region's designation as a UNESCO World Heritage Site as fact and fiction blend to reveal the romance of the Land of Evangeline. Visit a local winery for a tour and tasting before returning to Halifax for a two-night stay. (Breakfast)

DAY 7 : HALIFAX / SOUTH SHORE TOURING

Discover the rustic charm of the renowned fishing village of Peggy's Cove, where you will enjoy breakfast overlooking one of the most photographed lighthouses in the world. Continue along the South Shore to the UNESCO World Heritage Town of Lunenburg, renowned for its fleet of Grand Banks fishing schooners. Take a walking tour to fully experience one of the most remarkably preserved colonial settlements in the New World, and visit the Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic to learn about the town's rich seafaring heritage. (Breakfast)

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DAY 8 : HALIFAX, NS - CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI

Learn about the Mi'kmaq people at the Millbrook Cultural & Heritage Centre before crossing Confederation Bridge, the world's longest continuous multi-span bridge, to Prince Edward Island. Check into your Charlottetown accommodations for a two-night stay. (Continental Breakfast)

DAY 9 : PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TOURING

Enjoy a free morning in Charlottetown, Canada's birthplace, or join a complimentary walking tour of the city. This afternoon, tour the scenic North Shore, passing red cliffs, white beaches, gently sloping sand dunes, and the green fields of Prince Edward Island National Park. Visit Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place, the beloved inspiration for Lucy Maud Montgomery's classic novels. This evening, experience true Maritime hospitality at a traditional hall-style lobster supper. (Breakfast, Lobster Dinner)

Night in Charlottetown, Rodd Charlottetown 4*

DAY 10 : CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI - BADDECK, NS

Ferry over the Northumberland Strait back to Nova Scotia and proceed to Cape Breton Island, the Scotland of North America, via the Canso Causeway. See the beautiful Bras d'Or Lake from the water as you board a unique sightseeing boat tour. Spend the next two nights in the charming village of Baddeck. (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 11 : CABOT TRAIL TOURING

Experience one of the most stunningly picturesque drives in North America today as you tour the Cabot Trail which winds around the rocky splendor of Cape Breton's northern shore, ascending to the incredible plateaus of Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Look-offs offer unforgettable vistas of Cape Breton's rugged coastline so be sure to have your camera on hand. Also, visit Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site to learn of the many accomplishments of this genius who made his home on the island. (Breakfast, Boxed Lunch, Dinner)

Night in Baddeck, Inverary Resort 3*

DAY 12 : BADDECK - HALIFAX, NS

Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site awaits today and words cannot do justice to this reconstruction depicting one fifth of the settlement of 1744 New France. Proceed along the shore of the Bras d'Or Lake to the mainland, and back to Halifax for one last night in the Maritimes.
