

# BEST OF CAMBODIA

## PHNOM PENH, KAMPONG THOM, SIEM REAP

Discover the best of Cambodia, from the vibrant streets and royal splendor of Phnom Penh to the ancient wonders of Angkor. In the capital, explore the Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda, admire Khmer art at the National Museum, and wander the bustling Central or Russian Markets for local crafts and souvenirs. Then journey north to Siem Reap and step back in time at Angkor, where delicate carvings, jungle-clad temples, and grand pyramids showcase the scale and beauty of Cambodia's ancient civilization. This tour blends history, culture, and breathtaking architecture for an unforgettable experience.



### DAY 1: ARRIVE IN PHNOM PENH

Welcome to Cambodia. Transfer by air-conditioned vehicle to the hotel (8 km). Discover what Cambodia's capital has to offer. The riverfront promenade along the mighty Mekong is a hive of activity, from chaotic traffic to bustling pavements lined with street vendors. Visit the National Museum and the Silver Pagoda within the Royal Palace complex, the official residence of King Norodom Sihamoni. Enjoy time for shopping at one of the city's vibrant markets, either the art deco Central Market or the sprawling Russian Market, perfect for locally made silk, handicrafts, jewellery, and more. Transfer to the hotel. Evening at leisure.

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### DAY 2: PHNOM PENH

About an hour from Phnom Penh lie several impressive late Angkor-period temples, still largely undiscovered by mass tourism. Their quiet setting near Tonle Bati, a peaceful lake popular with locals, adds to their charm. Explore the temples of Ta Prohm and Phnom Da, and visit Angkor Borei, one of Cambodia's oldest archaeological sites. (Approx. 10 hours)

### DAY 3: PHNOM PENH - KAMPONG THOM

Poor Oudong has had a colourful past! This former mountain capital was sacked by the Thais, bombed by the Americans, and devastated by the Khmer Rouge. Explore the remains of stupas, tombs, and memorials, and enjoy the views from the hilltops. A stop at a silversmiths' village is included on the way to Kampong Thom. Today's Highlights: Oudong, Vihear Preah Ath Roes, Prasat Kuhak Nokor, silversmithing village (185 km)

### DAY 4: KAMPONG THOM - SIEM REAP, TONLE SAP

Discover a group of temples hidden in the forest at Sambor Prei Kuk, a site even older than Angkor and still largely untouched by mass tourism. Walk along narrow jungle paths to explore the peaceful ruins. Continue by road from Kampong Thom to Siem Reap (160 km). Enjoy a relaxing boat trip at Kampong Kleang, a fishing community on the edge of Tonle Sap Lake. Cruise past wooden houses on towering stilts, submerged forests, and fish farms (approx. 4 hours). Arrival in Siem Reap, check-in, and time at leisure.

### DAY 5: SIEM REAP

Enjoy a full day exploring Angkor. Start at Angkor Wat, Cambodia's iconic temple known for its grand scale, exquisite carvings, and serene central sanctuary. Cross the moat and naga-lined causeway, then admire bas reliefs depicting Hindu myths and nearly 1,700 apsaras. Sunrise or sunset are especially beautiful here. Next, visit Angkor Thom, a vast fortified city. Enter through the South Gate, then explore the Terrace of the Elephants, Terrace of the Leper King, Baphuon, Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, and the famous Bayon Temple with its giant stone faces. Discover Ta Prohm, where jungle roots weave through ancient ruins, creating a unique atmosphere. End the day watching the sunset from an Angkorian temple terrace over the countryside.

### DAY 6: SIEM REAP

Continue exploring some of Angkor's most remarkable temples. Banteay Srei, built from pink sandstone, is renowned for its delicate and well-preserved carvings. Visit Banteay Samre, a mid-12th-century temple dedicated to Vishnu. Explore Preah Khan, built by King Jayavarman VII, featuring large enclosures and narrow corridors within a rectangular wall. Visit Neak Pean, a Buddhist temple centered around a large pool with smaller surrounding pools. See Pre Rup, a pyramid-shaped temple built by Rajendravarma II, named after a traditional cremation practice. Visit Ta Som, built in the late 12th century by Jayavarman VII for his teacher. Explore East Mebon, an ancient temple sharing architectural features with Pre Rup.

Transfer to the airport for your onward journey.
