DAY 2: LIMA

Experience Lima at its most refined through an immersive culinary journey in South America's gastronomic capital. Begin with a visit to a vibrant local market in San Isidro, where Peru's extraordinary biodiversity and 84 microclimates, stretching from the Pacific coast to the Andes and the Amazon, come to life. Explore the colorful bohemian district of Barranco before learning the art of preparing classic ceviche and discovering the flavors of Peru's iconic pisco. Enjoy a memorable lunch at the renowned Astrid y Gastón, where celebrated chefs Gastón Acurio and Astrid Gutsche elevate traditional Peruvian ingredients into contemporary masterpieces. In the afternoon, explore Lima's beautifully preserved colonial center, including the Cathedral and the historic Santo Domingo Convent. Conclude the day with an exceptional dinner at Central, ranked among the World's 50 Best Restaurants, where chef Virgilio Martínez crafts an innovative dining experience inspired by Peru's diverse landscapes and native ingredients.

DAY 3: LIMA – CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY

This morning, transfer to the airport to board your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. This impressive Andean valley is home to important archaeological sites and picturesque towns that preserve their ancestral culture. Enjoy a special lunch experience at the Alqa Museum of Andean Popular Art. The museum's gastronomic offering pays tribute to the Andean farmer and to the concepts and practices of pre Hispanic nutrition, which according to current knowledge surpassed even the highest levels of contemporary scientific understanding. Later, visit Ollantaytambo, considered one of the most important towns of the Inca era and the main gateway to the majestic citadel of Machu Picchu. The village remains one of the best preserved Inca settlements.

Night in Sacred Valley

DAY 4: SACRED VALLEY

Begin your day in the Sacred Valley with a soulful sound healing circle, where ancient Peruvian instruments help align your energy and awaken your spirit. Continue to the traditional village of Chinchero, home to master weavers, and discover the artistry behind Andean textiles, colored with natural dyes derived from plants, minerals, and insects. Set against a backdrop of snow-capped peaks, Huaypo Lake provides a serene setting for a refined farm-to-table picnic prepared by your private chef. Later, take part in a meaningful ceremony led by an Andean priest, honoring Mother Earth as a source of life and abundance, and offering a moment for gratitude, intention, and spiritual connection. The day continues with a visit to the ancient salt mines, where thousands of terraced pools still produce salt using a centuries-old evaporation method. Conclude this enriching experience with dinner at Hacienda Huayocari, enjoying warm Peruvian hospitality and authentic homemade cuisine in an elegant, historic setting.

DAY 5: SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU

This morning, transfer to the train station to board the Vistadome to KM104, the starting point of the final stretch of the Inca Trail leading to the legendary Machu Picchu, a masterpiece of Inca architecture and engineering and one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Along the way, visit Chachabamba and the impressive archaeological complex of Wiñay Wayna. Then continue hiking along one of the best-preserved sections of the Inca Trail, crossing a lush cloud forest home to more than 300 species of orchids. The journey culminates at the Sun Gate, Inti Punku. As you pass through the gate, you will be rewarded with your first breathtaking view of the majestic Inca citadel of Machu Picchu.

DAY 6: MACHU PICHU – CUSCO

This morning, explore the Sanctuary of Machu Picchu, the most important cultural and spiritual center of the Inca civilization. The citadel was built in an extraordinary setting surrounded by lush vegetation between two mountains: Machu Picchu (Old Mountain) and Huayna Picchu (Young Mountain). Optional climb (\$) to Huayna Picchu Mountain, a natural viewpoint offering striking views of the citadel. In the afternoon, return to Cusco aboard the deluxe train Hiram Bingham. Enjoy a gourmet dinner and live music as the journey moves from cloud forests to Andean peaks, an unforgettable experience. Upon arrival at the train station, reception and transfer to your hotel in Cusco.

Night in Cusco

DAY 7: CUSCO

This morning, visit Sacsayhuaman, an ancient Inca fortress high on the hill above Cusco. Then explore Koricancha, the Temple of the Sun, where the Inca Sun God was worshipped. In the afternoon, enjoy free time to explore the city. Visit some of Cusco's favorite artists, such as Don Tater, a versatile ceramicist, or walk through the San Blas neighborhood, traditionally home to renowned local artisans.

DAY 8: CUSCO – PUNO – LAKE TITICACA

Transfer to the train station to board the train to Puno. The train ride follows a historic route between Cusco and Puno along the shores of Lake Titicaca. During the first half of the journey, enjoy magnificent views of the Andes Mountains. In the second half, the landscape transitions to smooth rolling plains, where you can spot vicuñas and alpacas. Upon arrival in Puno, located on the shores of Lake Titicaca, transfer to your hotel. Lake Titicaca, considered the sacred cradle of Inca culture, sits at 12,504 feet above sea level, making it one of the highest navigable lakes in the world.

DAY 9: LAKE TITICACA

Today, explore the remarkable floating islands of the Uros on Lake Titicaca. These islands are home to a people who trace their ancestry back to some of the oldest families in the Americas, and they continue to preserve their ancient traditions. Their homes, carefully crafted from totora reeds, float gracefully on the lake's shimmering surface, creating a scene unlike any other.

Next, explore the extraordinary Island of Taquile, where life seems to move at its own gentle pace. The island's Mediterranean-like charm is seen in its stone stairways and houses arranged around the central square. Approximately 350 families of Inca descent live here, keeping their cultural heritage alive through masterful textile arts. Witness the intricate weaving of chumps (belts), the colorful chullos (caps), and traditional jotas (sandals), each piece a testament to centuries of skill. Return to your hotel in the afternoon.

Night in Puno

DAY 10: LAKE TITICACA – LIMA – DEPART

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Lima. End of services.
