Discover its treasures through a thoughtfully curated journey emphasizing exceptional service, immersive experiences, and the expertise of carefully selected local specialists and authentic guides.



## DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN LIMA

Upon arrival in Lima, meet and greet and transfer to your hotel.

### Night in Lima



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### DAY 2: LIMA

This morning, discover Lima, the capital of Peru. On a city tour of Colonial Lima, visit the Cathedral in the Main Square, originally built in 1555. Enjoy panoramic views of the Government Palace and the Municipal Hall before driving through historic streets lined with traditional mansions and Moorish-style balconies. Continue to Casa Aliaga, a colonial mansion granted in 1535 by the conquistador Francisco Pizarro to his captain Jerónimo de Aliaga. Remarkably, it remains owned by the same family today. Lunch will be at Mayta Restaurant, a contemporary Peruvian restaurant and pisco bar founded by chef Jaime Pesaque, who trained in Europe and worked in Michelin-starred restaurants in Italy and Spain, including El Celler de Can Roca. After lunch, visit the Gold Museum to see its remarkable collection of gold artifacts from pre-Hispanic Andean civilizations. Dinner this evening will be at Central Restaurant, led by renowned chef Virgilio Martínez. The restaurant showcases Peru's diverse ecosystems through innovative cuisine, highlighting native ingredients and sustainable practices.

### DAY 3: LIMA – CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY

This morning, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Lunch will be placed in the most emblematic "hacienda" in Cusco's Sacred Valley, called "Huayocari," owned by the Lámbarri Orihuela family. It has beautiful architecture and a privileged view of the valley. You will learn about the sustainable agricultural practices transcending generations and the combination of flavourful, natural, and healthy ingredients found in the Andean highlands. After lunch, return to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the afternoon free to acclimatize properly to the altitude.

### DAY 4: SACRED VALLEY

Today visit Chinchero, a traditional Andean village and renowned weaving community. At a local workshop, learn how artisans use natural plants and minerals to create the vibrant dyes used in their textiles. You will also meet Nilda Callañaupa Alvarez, founder of the Centro de Textiles Tradicionales de Cusco, an organization dedicated to preserving and promoting traditional weaving techniques among young Peruvians. Continue to the Maras Salt Mines, where salt has been harvested since pre-Inca times using an ancient evaporation method. Next, visit the archaeological site of Moray, a series of remarkable circular terraces believed to have served as an Inca agricultural laboratory for experimenting with crops in different microclimates. Enjoy a special culinary experience at Mil Restaurant, created by chef Virgilio Martínez. Located near the Moray ruins, the restaurant highlights the Andean landscape through ingredients, traditional techniques, and local agricultural knowledge. Meet local community members and learn about life in the high Andes while discovering the rich cultural traditions of the region.

### DAY 5: SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU

This morning, transfer to the train station to board the Vistadome train to the legendary Machu Picchu, a masterpiece of Inca architecture and engineering and one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Built between the mountains of Machu Picchu ("Old Mountain") and Huayna Picchu ("Young Mountain"), the ancient citadel overlooks the winding Urubamba (Vilcanota) River and is surrounded by lush cloud forest rich in flora and fauna. Enjoy a guided tour of this extraordinary site before returning to your hotel.

#### Night in Machu Picchu



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### DAY 6: MACHU PICHU - CUSCO

This morning, meet with your guide for your second entrance to the Sanctuary of Machu Picchu, where you will walk towards the “Huayna Picchu” mountain entrance. Located to the southwest of the Citadel of Machu Picchu at 3,050 m.a.s.l., throughout the walk, you will have an incomparable view of the famous Inca sanctuary and a panoramic view of the surrounding mountains. Also, from here, you will achieve an incredible view of Machu Picchu, showing you how the mountain is carefully integrated into the nature around it. In the afternoon, return to Cusco aboard the Vistadome. Transfer to your hotel.

#### Night in Cusco

### DAY 7: CUSCO

In the morning, visit Sacsayhuaman; this massive Inca fortress was built on three overlapping platforms. Then, visit Cusco's Historical Inca and Spanish Colonial Monuments, such as the Main Square, known in Inca times as Huacaypata or the Warrior's Square; it was the scene for many key events in Cusco's history. Continue onto the Church and Convent of Santo Domingo, a Spanish construction belonging to the Dominican Order built upon the foundations of the Inca temple of Koricancha or Temple of the Sun. Koricancha was the main religious building of the Incas dedicated to worshipping the Sun and whose walls, according to the chroniclers, were plated with sheets of gold. Next, you will discover the art and artisans of San Blas's multicolored neighborhood. Here you will find the best master artisans, sculptors, and painters. A labyrinthine network of narrow streets, some of which are pedestrians-only.

#### Night in Cusco

### DAY 8: CUSCO – IQUITOS – AMAZON CRUISE DELFIN III

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Iquitos, where the Delfin III crew will welcome you upon arrival. Enjoy a lunchbox as you travel by road to Nauta, a small riverside town on the banks of the Marañón River and the first city founded in the Loreto region. At Nauta's private port, receive a VIP welcome before boarding the Delfin III. Once on board, settle into your comfortable suite, featuring orthopedic beds, fine cotton linens, natural latex pillows, air conditioning, a private bathroom with hot water, and a spacious private terrace. As the vessel begins its journey along the Marañón River, take in panoramic views from the observation deck. Your naturalist guide will provide an introduction to the itinerary, activities, wildlife, and the fascinating geography and history of the Amazon. Later, explore the Pahuachiro area, an excellent spot for birdwatching and observing playful monkeys. Enjoy the magical colors of your first Amazon sunset—a perfect opportunity for photography.

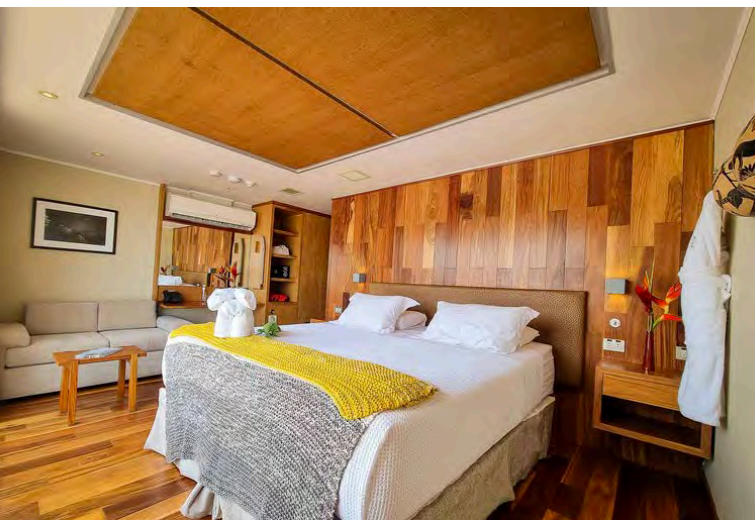


## MAJESTY OF PERU - 11 DAYS / 10 NIGHTS

### DAY 9: AMAZON CRUISE DELFIN III

Rise early to explore one of the most important areas of the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, when wildlife is most active. Board skiffs and head into a region of towering trees and old palms, home to many bird species, including several varieties of parrots. Keep an eye out for the unusual hoatzin, often nesting just above the water, as well as the elusive three-toed sloth. You will also have the opportunity to meet Carola, a respected spiritual healer who serves many remote jungle communities. Known as a “white” shaman, she is recognized as a healer and spiritual guide, offering insight into traditional Amazonian beliefs and practices. Later, cruise along the Yanayacu and Pucate Rivers, exploring hidden creeks and lagoons within one of the most pristine areas of the reserve. Your naturalist guide will help spot the region’s remarkable biodiversity. You may also choose to explore the waterways by kayak or paddleboard and, with luck, see the famous pink river dolphins. After dinner, enjoy a night safari along Nauta Caño, searching for nocturnal wildlife.

### DAY 10: AMAZON CRUISE DELFIN III

Explore Nauta Caño Creek, an area rich in wildlife, where you may spot squirrel monkeys, silver-backed tamarins, birds, dolphins, and even sloths. Scan the riverbanks for small caimans, colorful insects, and spiders, and try fishing for the famous piranha in the calm waters. Later, visit a local riverside community, where friendly residents will welcome you and share aspects of their daily life. Learn how cassava is peeled and grated, and see the traditional tools used to process locally grown rice, offering a glimpse into the simple yet rewarding lifestyle of the Amazon’s ribereño communities. Continue with a guided walk along the Fundo Casual jungle trail, venturing into terra firme (non-flooded forest). Your guide will introduce you to the diverse flora and fauna of the rainforest. Keep your eyes open for remarkable wildlife, including anacondas, rainbow boas, tarantulas, poison frogs, porcupines, and the elusive two-toed sloth, sometimes seen in this part of the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve.

### DAY 11: AMAZON CRUISE DELFIN III – IQUITOS - LIMA - DEPART

On your journey from Nauta to Iquitos Airport, visit the Rescue & Rehabilitation Center of River Mammals (Amazon Forever). Here you will meet rescued baby manatees and learn about these gentle, endangered creatures and the conservation efforts to protect them. The center also cares for other animals rescued from illegal capture and unsafe conditions.

You are welcome to support this important conservation initiative with a donation if you wish.

Upon arrival at the airport, staff will assist you with check-in and provide your boarding passes for your flight to Lima. Your guide and the Delfin III crew will bid you farewell at the security gate. Arrival in Lima and connection with your international flight home. End of services.
