

Stroll along Insadong, famous for traditional shops, galleries, tea houses, and handicrafts. Discover Namsangol Hanok Village, featuring restored Korean houses and gardens. End with panoramic city views from N Seoul Tower on Namsan Mountain.

## SOUTH KOREA, SEOUL & BUSAN - 6 DAYS / 5 NIGHTS

### DAY 3: SEOUL - BUSAN

Check out from hotel and head out to visit The Dongdaemun Design Plaza (DDP), a futuristic landmark in the heart of Seoul. It serves as a major cultural hub, hosting a variety of events such as art exhibitions, fashion shows, design markets, and cultural performances. Continue to the T.um Museum, an interactive tech museum focusing on showcasing cutting-edge technologies and innovations in the fields of telecom, artificial intelligence (AI), virtual reality (VR), and the Internet of Things (IoT). The museum's goal is to inspire visitors about the potential of technology and its role in shaping the future. Continue to the train station for the high-speed train to Busan. Travel on train without guide. On arrival in Busan, you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

### DAY 4: BUSAN

Meet your private guide for a tour of Busan. Hedong Yeongunsa Temple is on the east coast and one of the few temples located by the sea, attracting tourists by its marvelous surroundings. Blue Line Coastal Train: The Haeundae Blue Linepark is an eco-friendly reconstruction of an old railway line that runs along the seashore for 4.8 kilometers, offering visitors magnificent sea views while riding the excursion train. Cheongsapho Daritdol Viewing Grounds: This viewing platform offers stunning panoramic views of the East Sea (Sea of Japan), the surrounding coastline, and the beautiful natural landscape. Haeundae Coast is one of Busan's most famous beaches, known for its golden sands and stunning views of the sea. Nearby, Dongbaek Island is a scenic spot connected to the mainland by a walking trail, featuring lush greenery, beautiful coastal views, and the iconic Nurimaru APEC House. Together, they provide a perfect blend of natural beauty and cultural landmarks, making them must-visit spots in Busan.

### DAY 5: BUSAN - SEOUL

Before you head back to Seoul, meet your guide and visit Gamcheon Cultural Village: It consists of alleyways of houses built in the form of stairs at the foot of the mountain. They create such a picturesque scene that the village is even called Busan's Machu Picchu. Tourists can take part in a tour to see the various themed houses and original figures in the alleyways, and enjoy workshops conducted by locals. Taejongdae Park: A beautiful coastal park known for its dramatic cliffs, lush forests, and panoramic ocean views. The park offers scenic walking trails, a lighthouse, and a stunning view of the surrounding sea, making it an ideal spot for photography. Gukje International Market: A bustling and vibrant traditional market established during the Korean War, it is one of the largest and most famous markets in the city. Transfer to the train station for the high-speed train back to Seoul. Meet your driver upon arrival and transfer to your hotel.
