Then, escape to the serene island of Jeju, known for its picturesque landscapes, from the majestic Hallasan Mountain to the stunning waterfalls and unique volcanic beaches. ### DAY 2: SEOUL - JEJU

The house of Samdal and Yongpil: Offers a unique glimpse into traditional Korean architecture and culture. Ojo Bay: A tranquil and scenic spot known for its picturesque views and serene atmosphere, and its unique rock formations. Transfer to your hotel and check-in.

### DAY 3: JEJU

Meet your guide and start your visit of Jeju.

**Cheonjeyeon Waterfall:** The waterfall is made up of three distinct drops, and visitors can enjoy walking along the well-maintained paths to reach the falls. **Osulloc Tea Museum:** A unique cultural spot that introduces visitors to Jeju's tea culture, particularly its famous green tea. The museum displays the history and process of tea production, along with a collection of tea-related items. **Hallim Park:** One of Jeju's most famous natural attractions and offers a mix of tropical and subtropical plant species. **Geumneung Beach:** A quiet and scenic beach famous for its clear waters and soft, white sand. It's a great spot for swimming, sunbathing, or just relaxing by the sea. Dinner at Solhyang Bada Garden (Korean BBQ)

### DAY 4: JEJU - SEOUL

Check out and meet your guide for a few last scenic spots on Jeju before heading back to Seoul.

**Sono Calm Jeju:** A resort complex with a beautiful garden and a walking path along the beach. **Segial Beach:** A lesser-known quiet beach with a peaceful atmosphere. The beach has clear, calm waters and fine sand, making it great for a calm swim or a leisurely stroll along the shore. **Donmun Traditional Market:** A lively and vibrant spot where locals and tourists alike can experience the authentic atmosphere of a traditional Korean market, offering a variety of local products, fresh food, and handicrafts. Continue to the airport for your flight to Seoul. Meet your driver and transfer to your hotel.

### DAY 5: SEOUL

Meet your guide and start your discovery of Seoul.

**Bongeunsa Temple:** Located in the Gangnam district A beautiful and tranquil Buddhist temple that offers a peaceful escape.

**COEX Starfield Library:** An iconic, modern public library with an impressive, open design. The library's most striking feature is its towering bookshelves that stretch up to the ceiling, creating a visually stunning space.

**National Museum:** One of the largest museums in South Korea offering an extensive collection of artifacts that showcase the country's rich cultural heritage.

**Han River Cruise:** A relaxing and scenic journey along the river where you can enjoy views of the city's skyline, bridges, parks, and the natural beauty surrounding the riverbanks. Dinner at E-Mart24 Hangang Paradise: E-Mart24 is a chain of 24-hour convenience stores in Korea, and the one at Hangang Paradise has small seating areas where you can enjoy quick meals like ramen, kimbap (Korean sushi rolls), or bento boxes. It's a unique experience, offering easy and affordable dining with a great view of the river.

### DAY 6: SEOUL

Meet your private guide and continue your tour of Seoul. Gyeongbokgung Palace: It is the largest of the Five Grand Palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty (1392–1897) and is often considered the most beautiful and historically significant palace in Seoul. Hanbok Experience included: Wearing a traditional hanbok (the traditional Korean attire) allows you to experience Korean history and heritage in a more personal way, and it's also a fantastic way to take memorable photos against the beautiful backdrop of the palace. Insadong Artisan Street: A famous street in downtown Seoul for its atmosphere of traditional Korean culture. It is a mix of old stores, galleries, tea houses and souvenir stores offering antiques, paintings, calligraphy and handicrafts. Namsangol Hanok Village: Includes 5 Korean-style houses, pavilions, traditional gardens, and other buildings and recreational areas. For a great view, check out N Seoul Tower (also known as Namsan Seoul Tower) a famous observation tower located on Namsan Mountain in central Seoul. At 236 meters (774 feet) tall, it provides spectacular panoramic views of the city.
