From the bustling streets of Seoul to the serene beauty of Jeju Island, this tour takes you to some of the country's most iconic destinations. Explore the picturesque coastal city of Sokcho, the charming seaside town of Gangneung, the traditional heritage of Andong, and delve into the historical wonders of Gyeongju and the dynamic energy of Busan. DAY 1: SEOUL

Arrive at Seoul airport. Meet your guide and private transfer to the hotel.

Night in Seoul

DAY 2: SEOUL

Meet your guide and start your tour of Seoul.

Gyeongbokgung Palace: The largest of the Five Grand Palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty (1392–1897). Insadong Artisan Street: A famous street known for its atmosphere of traditional Korean culture. It is a mix of old stores, galleries, tea houses and souvenir stores offering antiques, paintings, calligraphy and handicrafts. Namsangol Hanok Village: 5 Korean-style houses, pavilions, traditional gardens, and other buildings and recreational areas. For a great view, check out N Seoul Tower (also known as Namsan Seoul Tower) a famous observation tower at 236 meters (774 feet) tall.

DAY 3: SEOUL - SOKCHO/GANGNEUNG

Meet your guide and transfer to Sokcho. Visits today will include: Sokcho Beach: An ideal spot for relaxation, sunbathing, and scenic surroundings. The beach is also famous for its breathtaking views of the nearby Seoraksan Mountain. Seoraksan National Park (+cable car): Famous for its towering granite peaks, lush valleys, and vibrant foliage. Stop at a traditional market. Naksansa Temple: One of South Korea's most iconic and serene Buddhist temples with a history that dates back to the 7th century". The temple is known for its stunning location, surrounded by lush greenery and offering magnificent views of the ocean.

DAY 4: GANGNEUNG - ANDONG

Today, head to Andong for some sightseeing and an overnight: Ojukheon House: One of Korea's most treasured historical sites. This house was the birthplace of the famous Confucian scholar Yi I (also known as Yulgok), one of Korea's greatest intellectuals. Anmok Beach: Famous for its scenic beauty and also for its vibrant "Coffee Street." This stretch of coastline is lined with a variety of cozy cafes with views of the beach and sea. For art enthusiasts, Hasla Art World Museum blends contemporary art with a stunning natural setting, and showcases modern artworks and sculptures, many of which are inspired by the surrounding landscape. The museum's serene atmosphere and innovative exhibitions make it a must-visit for those seeking a cultural experience beyond traditional galleries.

Night in Andong

DAY 5: ANDONG - GYEONGJU

Check out and head to Gyeongju with stops along the way. Dosan seowon Confucian academy: a well-preserved Confucian academy founded in the 16th century. The site is a tranquil place where you can immerse yourself in the serenity of Korean Confucianism, surrounded by nature and traditional Korean architecture. It is also a UNESCO World Heritage site. Hahoe Village: A traditional Korean village that has been remarkably well-preserved and is also recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue to Gyeongju. Donggung Palace: Also known as the Gyeongju Palace, was a secondary palace built for the crown prince during the Silla Dynasty. The palace was partially reconstructed, and visitors can explore the grounds where the royal family once resided. The nearby Wolji Pond is famous for its beautiful, serene water and the reflection of surrounding architecture, especially at night when the structures are lit up, creating a magical atmosphere. Check in to your hotel.

DAY 6: GYEONGJU - ANCIENT KOREA

Meet your private guide and travel back 1,000 years in time: Meet your private guide and travel back 1,000 years in time: Seokguram Grotto: A UNESCO World Heritage site on Mount Tohamsan, home to a magnificent stone Buddha and a masterpiece of Korean Buddhist art. Cheonmachong Tomb: A well-preserved royal tomb in Gyeongju Tumuli Park from the Silla period. Hwangnidan Street: A lively area mixing traditional architecture with trendy cafés, shops, and restaurants.

DAY 7: GYEONGJU - BUSAN

Depart for Busan, known for its beautiful beaches. Visit: Hedong Yeongsusa Temple: one of the few temples located by the sea, attracting tourists by its marvelous surroundings. Blue Line Coastal Train: The Haeundae Blue Linepark is an eco-friendly reconstruction of an old railway line that runs along the seashore for 4.8 kilometers, offering visitors magnificent sea views while riding the excursion train. The X The SKY observation deck is one of Busan's latest attractions, offering breathtaking views of the city.

DAY 8: BUSAN - JEJU

Check out and visit Jagalchi Fish Market, the largest seafood market in South Korea and one of Busan's most iconic spots, offering an authentic glimpse of Korean coastal life. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Jeju Island. Upon arrival, meet your driver/guide and begin sightseeing: Hallim Park: A famous Jeju attraction featuring beautiful gardens and a wide variety of tropical and subtropical plants. Cheonjeyeon Waterfall: A scenic three-tier waterfall with well-maintained walking paths leading to each level.

DAY 9: EAST JEJU

Enjoy sightseeing with your private guide: Jeju Jeolmul Recreational Forest: Peaceful forest for hiking and relaxation with views of Mount Hallasan. Seongeup Folk Village: Traditional village with historic stone houses and thatched roofs. Gwangchigi Beach: Quiet beach with views of Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak. Haenyeo – Female Divers: See Jeju's famous women divers, a UNESCO-recognized tradition. Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak): Iconic crater peak known for spectacular views. Jongdalri Coastal Road: Scenic drive along Jeju's rugged coastline. Jeju Stone Park: Discover Jeju's volcanic heritage through stone sculptures and exhibits.

Night in Jeju

DAY 10: SOUTH JEJU

Meet your private guide and continue your tour of Jeju. Mystery Road: A road where gravity seems to defy itself, with objects appear to roll uphill due to an optical illusion. Halla Mountain (Hallasan): South Korea's tallest mountain, offering various hiking trails with scenic views, volcanic landscapes, and a crater at the summit. Revitalized Museum: The Jeju Folk Village Museum showcases traditional Jeju culture, with interactive exhibits and displays of local heritage. Jusangjeolli Cliff: Stunning hexagonal basalt columns formed by volcanic activity, located on Jeju's southern coast, perfect for photos. Jeongbang Waterfall: A unique waterfall dropping directly into the ocean.

DAY 11: JEJU - SEOUL - DAY AT LEISURE

Transfer to the airport and flight to Seoul. Meet your driver and transfer to your hotel for your last night in South Korea. Enjoy some last minute shopping and local street food.

Private transfer to the international airport.
