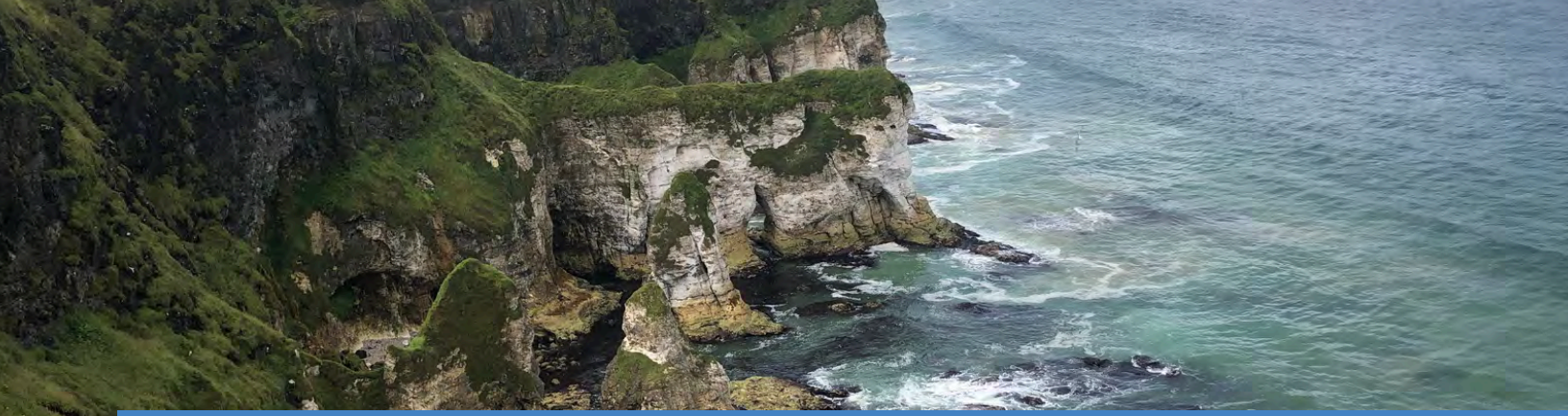

### DAY 3 : EDINBURGH - BELFAST by air
