Delhi – Agra – Ranthambore – Jaipur

Discover the essence of North India on a journey through Delhi, Agra, Ranthambore, and Jaipur. From Delhi's energetic streets, spiritual landmarks, and colorful markets to Agra's iconic monuments and rich Mughal heritage, each stop reveals a new layer of culture. Experience the thrill of a wildlife safari in Ranthambore's natural reserve, surrounded by open landscapes and diverse habitats. End your adventure in Jaipur, where royal traditions, vibrant bazaars, and flavorful Rajasthani cuisine create a truly unforgettable finale.



DAY 1: DELHI

Arrive at Delhi Airport. Meet and greet and transfer to your hotel. Delhi isn't just one city, but a collection of many, each with its own unique charm. What you see today is the result of seven ancient cities, each built, destroyed, and rebuilt over centuries. What remains is a dynamic metropolis that combines the ancient and the modern, where culture thrives beneath a surface of lively charm.

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DAY 2: DELHI

Enjoy a guided tour of Old Delhi. Take a cycle rickshaw ride through its narrow lanes and explore Chandni Chowk, a bustling market within the old city walls. Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, built between 1644 and 1658. Continue to New Delhi, driving past colonial-era landmarks that contrast with the city's Mughal architecture. Visit Humayun's Tomb, a stunning 16th-century UNESCO World Heritage Site and a masterpiece of Mughal design. Proceed to Nizamuddin Basti, where you'll meet inspiring local women and take part in a meaningful, hands-on workshop. End your tour with a visit to a Sikh temple, where you'll experience its serene atmosphere and learn about Sikh traditions. Return to your hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

DAY 3: DELHI - AGRA (205 kms, approx. 3.5hrs)

Morning drive to Agra, home of the Taj Mahal. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. In the afternoon or evening, visit Agra Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a splendid example of Mughal imperial architecture. The fort served as the residence of emperors for three generations and features beautiful pavilions, gardens, mosques, and royal halls blending Islamic and Hindu styles.

DAY 4: AGRA – FATEHPUR SIKRI – BHARATPUR – RANTHAMBORE (by car and train)

Early morning, witness the breathtaking sunrise over the iconic Taj Mahal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site (closed on Fridays) and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Known for its exquisite white marble symmetry, it is often called a "teardrop on the cheek of eternity." After your visit, return to the hotel for breakfast. Later, drive to Fatehpur Sikri, another UNESCO World Heritage Site and a stunning example of Mughal architecture. This abandoned red sandstone city was built by Emperor Akbar in the late 16th century as his capital but was deserted after 15 years due to water shortages. After exploring Fatehpur Sikri, continue to Bharatpur Railway Station to board your train to Ranthambore. Located in southeastern Rajasthan, Ranthambore National Park is a famed wildlife reserve and former royal hunting ground, known for its rich flora and fauna and frequent tiger sightings. Arrive in Ranthambore by evening, then transfer to your hotel for check-in and rest.

DAY 5: RANTHAMBORE

Early morning, set out for a shared jeep safari in Ranthambore National Park. Enjoy two guided safaris, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, giving you the chance to spot the park's famous tigers along with leopards, sloth bears, crocodiles, and a variety of birds. Travel in a comfortable open top jeep shared with other guests, while your guide points out and explains the park's rich wildlife and ecosystems.

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DAY 6: RANTHAMBORE - JAIPUR (180 kms, approx. 4hrs)

In the morning, enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel. Later, drive to Jaipur and transfer to your hotel upon arrival. In the evening, experience the vibrant bazaars of Jaipur, known for their exquisite textiles, unique artisanal goods, and delicious street food. Explore a specially curated selection of the city's textile markets and local delicacies, each reflecting Jaipur's rich culinary and cultural heritage. The textile markets, in particular, showcase centuries-old craftsmanship, with intricate patterns, vivid colours, and fine fabrics that capture the artistic soul of the Pink City.

DAY 7: JAIPUR

Start your day exploring Jaipur, a city of over 500 temples. Discover hidden sanctuaries adorned with ancient murals, enjoy a tea break with locals, and wander through colorful spice and flower markets, soaking in the city's vibrant heritage. Return to the hotel for breakfast, then drive to Amber Fort. Built in the 17th century by Maharaja Man Singh, the fort features sprawling courtyards, grand halls, and the dazzling Sheesh Mahal, where a single lamp reflects across countless mirrors. Next, visit the Anokhi Museum of Hand Printing in a beautiful haveli. Explore block-printed textiles, from traditional garments to contemporary designs, and learn about techniques like dabu mud-resist printing and gold and silver embellishments from expert guides. Return to the city to see Jantar Mantar, an 18th-century observatory with geometric instruments for tracking celestial movements. Just beside it, the City Palace showcases royal garments, miniature paintings, and treasures, while part of the palace remains home to the former royal family.

DAY 8: JAIPUR - DELHI DEPART (250 kms, approx. 5hrs)

Early check out and drive to Delhi airport for departure.
