ENCHANTING TAIWAN

Discover the beauty and natural wonders of Taiwan. Your Seat-in-coach journey begins in Taipei, with its National Museum, vibrant streets and ancient treasures and Sun Moon Lake, with tranquil waters and misty mountain vistas. Explore the rich heritage of Tainan, Taiwan's oldest city, known for its centuries-old temples, traditional architecture, and vibrant street food. Continue south to the lively port city of Kaohsiung, where art, culture, and spirituality meet. Unwind in the tropical paradise of Kenting, with its sun-drenched beaches and crystal-clear waters. Retreat to Chihpen Hot Springs, nestled in the lush mountains of Taitung, and soak in therapeutic mineral waters surrounded by nature. Finally, experience the awe-inspiring landscapes of Hualien, where marble canyons and waterfalls provide the perfect finale to this unforgettable seat-in-coach tour.



DAY 1: TAIPEI

Upon arrival at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE), you will be met and transferred to your hotel by private car (NO guide). The remainder of the day is at leisure.

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DAY 2: TAIPEI

After breakfast, enjoy a classic Taipei city tour exploring both historic landmarks and modern attractions. Visit the world-renowned National Palace Museum, home to one of the largest collections of ancient Chinese artifacts. Continue to Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, a landmark symbolizing an important era in Taiwan's history, and Lungshan Temple, a vibrant example of local religious traditions. Then see Taipei 101 (observatory ticket not included), the iconic skyscraper showcasing the city's modern development.

DAY 3: TAIPEI / SUN MOON LAKE

Depart from central Taipei to Sun Moon Lake, Taiwan's largest freshwater lake, named for its sun-like east side and crescent-shaped west side divided by Lalu Island. This scenic area is also home to the indigenous Thao people. After lunch (\$), enjoy a bus tour around the lake's top attractions. Visit Ita Thao village to experience Thao culture, then see the iconic Ci'en Pagoda, built by Chiang Kai-shek in memory of his mother. Continue to Xuanzang Temple, a peaceful Buddhist site, and Wenwu Temple, a grand complex honoring the Martial God and the God of Literature. With expert guide commentary throughout, gain deeper insight into the region's history and culture. End the day with a comfortable stay at a hotel in Sun Moon Lake or downtown Taichung.

DAY 4: SUN MOON LAKE / TAINAN / FO GUANG SHAN MONASTERY / KAOHSIUNG

Travel by bus to Tainan, Taiwan's oldest city. Visit Fort Zeelandia, originally built by the Dutch East India Company and later rebuilt by the Japanese after damage in the 19th century. Then stroll along Anping Old Street, established over 300 years ago and considered Taiwan's first officially named street, now famous for local specialties like tofu pudding, shrimp rolls, and beef soup. After lunch (\$), continue to the harbor city of Kaohsiung, the largest city in southern Taiwan. Visit the renowned Fo Guang Shan Monastery, home to the impressive 36-meter golden statue of Buddha Amitabha. During your visit, you'll have the chance to meet a monk and learn about the teachings and development of Buddhism in Taiwan.

DAY 5: KAOHSIUNG / KENTING / CHIHPEN HOT SPRINGS, TAITUNG

Head south to Kenting National Park, Taiwan's first national park, known for its dramatic coastal formations, scenic landscapes, and rich marine life. A haven for surfers and divers, Kenting offers stunning natural sights. Visit Maopitou ("Cat's Nose"), a rock formation resembling a crouching cat; Chuanfan Rock ("Sail Rock"), shaped like a ship's sail; Eluanpi Lighthouse, built during the Qing Dynasty; and Longpan Park, a coral limestone plateau overlooking the Pacific Ocean. Continue to Taitung via the scenic South Link Highway, enjoying ever-changing landscapes along the way. End the day with a relaxing stay at a hot spring resort in Zhiben, Taitung County, famous for its carbonate hot springs.

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DAY 6: TAITUNG / EAST COAST NATIONAL SCENIC AREA / HUALIEN / YILAN

After a restful night and breakfast, continue your Taiwan journey along the scenic east coast, one of the island's most unspoiled regions. Enjoy breathtaking landscapes as you visit Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping, and Fanshuliao, each known for unique geological formations shaped by wind and sea. Begin at Xiaoyeliu, also known as Fugang Geopark, where fascinating rock formations resemble those of Yehliu on the north coast. Then visit Sanxiantai, a picturesque offshore island connected by a bridge and a key landmark of the East Coast. Next, explore Shitiping, a remarkable sea erosion terrace featuring cliffs, grooves, and potholes formed over millions of years, often described as an outdoor geology classroom. Travel from Hualien to Yilan by comfortable one way train. Tonight, unwind at your hot spring hotel in Jiaoxi.

DAY 7: YILAN / TAIPEI

Get ready for your final day in Taiwan. Today, your guide will take you to the King Car Kavalan Whisky Distillery and the National Center for Traditional Arts. Start with a visit to King Car Kavalan Whisky Distillery, renowned worldwide for its exceptional whisky crafted from pure water sourced from the Central and Xueshan mountain ranges. Enjoy the rich aromas and discover the unique flavors developed in oak barrels during this engaging distillery experience. Next, visit the National Center for Traditional Arts, a spacious park showcasing beautiful traditional Taiwanese architecture. Explore exhibitions, performances, and hands on workshops that bring Taiwan's cultural heritage to life, from puppet shows to pottery making. Conclude your journey with a bus ride back to Taipei City.
