WONDERS OF ANCIENT EGYPT

Discover the wonders of Ancient Egypt and over 4,000 years of history as you explore the majestic temples of Luxor, the legendary Valley of the Kings, and the beautiful Temple of Philae dedicated to the goddess Isis. Journey along the Nile to the fascinating temples of Kom Ombo and Edfu, and experience the breathtaking rock cut temples of Abu Simbel, built by Ramses II and relocated in one of the world's greatest engineering achievements. Throughout your adventure, enjoy dramatic desert landscapes, stunning Nile views, and the comfort of travelling by private car with driver and local private guides, allowing you to explore at your own pace. .

DAY 1: CAIRO

Welcome to Cairo. Upon arrival at Cairo airport, you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your hote.

Night in Cairo: Cairo Marriott Hotel 5* (Deluxe room)

DAY 2: CAIRO

Full day tour to visit the Pyramids of Giza, the Sphinx, Memphis, and Sakkara. Visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, including entrance to the interior burial chamber, and see the legendary Sphinx of Giza, carved from natural limestone around 2620 BC, with the head of a Pharaoh and the body of a lion. A camel ride is also included. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before continuing to Memphis, the ancient capital of Upper and Lower Egypt during the First Dynasty over 5,000 years ago, and Sakkara, home to the famous Step Pyramid of King Zoser, the world's first pyramid. Dinner at a local restaurant.

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DAY 3: CAIRO - LUXOR (BY AIR)

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Luxor. Once known as ancient Thebes and the capital of Upper Egypt, Luxor is often referred to as the world's greatest open air museum. The Nile River divides the city into the East Bank and West Bank, symbolizing Life and Death in ancient times. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and check in. This afternoon, enjoy a half day tour of Luxor's East Bank, including the magnificent Luxor Temple, built mainly by Amenhotep III and Ramses II and once the center of the famous Opet Festival. Continue to the vast Karnak Temple Complex, covering more than 2 sq km and home to the impressive Temple of Amun Ra, along with numerous smaller temples and sacred structures. In the evening, experience the famous Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple.

Night in Luxor: Hilton Luxor Resort & Spa 5* (Classic garden view)

DAY 4: LUXOR

Half day tour of Luxor's West Bank, starting with the Valley of the Kings, a UNESCO World Heritage Site home to the richly decorated tombs of the pharaohs of the New Kingdom. Continue to the impressive Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a striking monument dedicated to one of Egypt's most powerful female rulers. Proceed to the Valley of the Queens, where royal consorts and children were buried, and end with a panoramic stop at the Colossi of Memnon, the iconic twin statues that have guarded the Theban necropolis for centuries.

Night in Luxor: Hilton Luxor Resort & Spa 5* (Classic garden view)

DAY 5: LUXOR / DENDERA & ABYDOS

Full day excursion to Dendera and Abydos. Drive approximately 1.5 hours to Dendera to visit the Temple of Hathor, one of the best preserved temple complexes in Egypt, known for its detailed carvings and striking astronomical ceiling. Continue onward to Abydos to explore the magnificent Temple of Seti I, an important pilgrimage site in ancient Egypt, celebrated for its beautifully decorated reliefs. Return to Luxor in the afternoon and overnight.

Night in Luxor: Hilton Luxor Resort & Spa 5* (Classic garden view)

DAY 6: LUXOR

Half day tour to Deir el Medina, the Valley of the Nobles, and Medinet Habu. The Valley of the Nobles is home to more than 140 numbered tombs of noblemen and high officials who served the pharaohs, mainly during the 18th Dynasty. Continue to Deir el Medina, located on the West Bank, once the village of the artisans and craftsmen who built the royal tombs in the Valley of the Kings. Proceed to Medinet Habu, one of the most impressive and best preserved temples of the New Kingdom, featuring the Mortuary Temple of Ramses III (1184-1153 BC), built to commemorate his reign. The complex is enclosed by a massive mud brick wall and remains one of the most striking monuments on the West Bank.

Night in Luxor: Hilton Luxor Resort & Spa 5* (Classic garden view)





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DAY 7: LUXOR - EDFU - KOM OMBO - ASWAN

Check out and transfer by private car to Aswan, with stops en route to visit two of Egypt's most remarkable temples. First is the Temple of Edfu, dedicated to Horus, the avenging son of Isis and Osiris, built during the Ptolemaic period. Continue to Kom Ombo, a unique double temple dating from 205 to 180 BC, dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris. Visit the nearby crocodile museum to see mummified crocodiles and reptiles. Arrive in Aswan and check in to your hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy a private felucca sail on the Nile, relaxing as you cruise around Kitchener Island, home to Egypt's largest botanical garden, originally developed by Lord Kitchener. Return to your hotel and overnight.

Night in Aswan: Sonesta Nouba Aswan 4*+

DAY 8: ASWAN

A short motorboat ride brings you to Philae Island to visit the Temple of Isis, one of Egypt's most beautiful sanctuaries. Continue to the nearby Unfinished Obelisk, still lying in its original quarry after a crack was discovered during carving, offering insight into ancient stone-working techniques. This afternoon, enjoy a half-day excursion to the Nubian Village on Soheil Island by motorboat. Discover the culture and traditions of the Nubian people, known for their colorful homes and rich heritage. Walk through the village, visit a local family, and enjoy traditional Nubian tea before returning to your hotel in the late afternoon.

Night in Aswan: Sonesta Nouba Aswan 4*+

DAY 9: ASWAN - ABU SIMBEL - CAIRO (BY AIR)

Early breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Abu Simbel. The temples of Abu Simbel, among the most magnificent monuments in the world, were built by Pharaoh Ramses II nearly 3,000 years ago. Remarkably, the entire complex was dismantled and relocated in the 1960s to higher ground to save it from rising waters caused by the construction of the Aswan High Dam. After the visit, transfer back to the airport for your flight to Cairo via Aswan. Upon arrival in Cairo, meet your guide and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Night in Cairo: Steigenberger Pyramids 4*+ (Garden view)

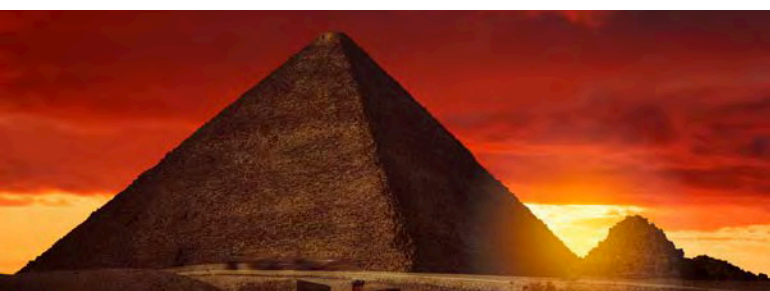
DAY 10: CAIRO

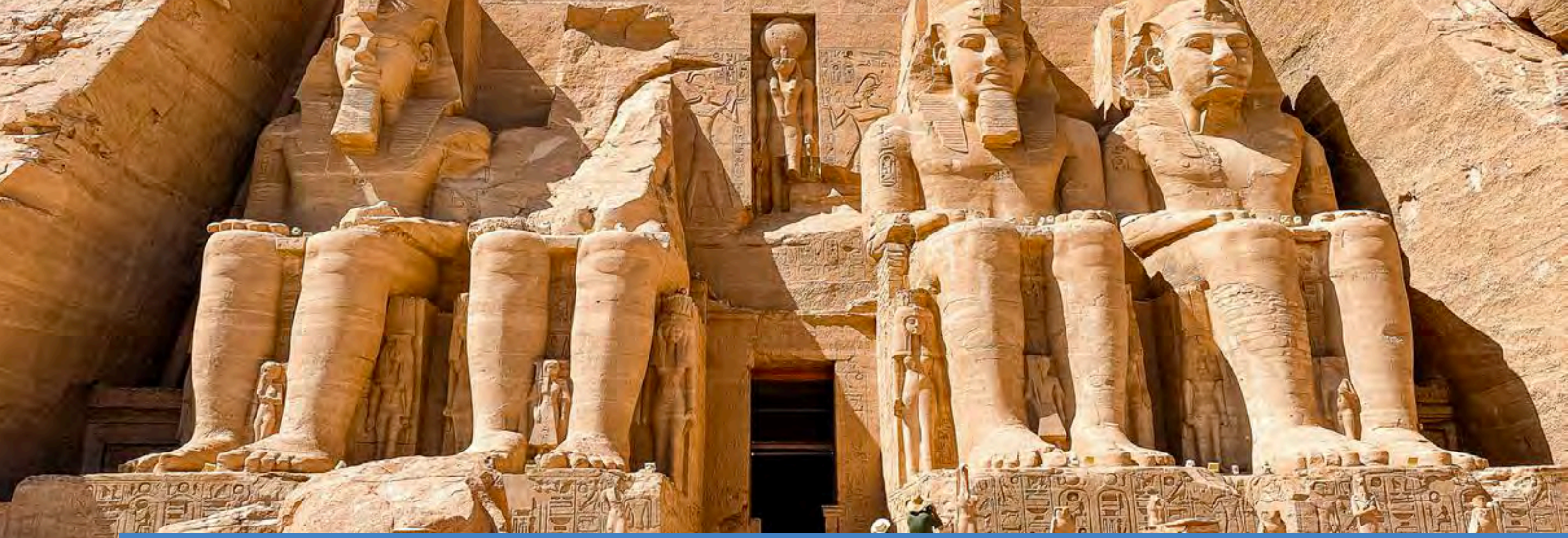
Begin your full day exploration with a transfer to the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM), one of the world's largest archaeological museums. Explore its vast galleries and discover iconic collections, including the treasures of Tutankhamun. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Continue to the Citadel of Saladin, a historic Islamic fortress overlooking Cairo, and visit its key landmarks, including the stunning Mohamed Ali Mosque, also known as the Alabaster Mosque. End the day at the lively Khan el Khalili bazaar, where you can shop and experience the vibrant atmosphere of old Cairo. Return to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

Night in Cairo: Steigenberger Pyramids 4*+ (Garden view)

DAY 11: CAIRO - DEPART

Say farewell to Egypt as you are transferred to Cairo Airport for your departure flight.
