CASABLANCA, RABAT, MEKNES, FEZ, MARRAKECH, AGADIR
12 DAYS / 11 NIGHTS

Discover Morocco's imperial cities, rich in history and culture. Fez, Marrakech, Meknes, and Rabat have all played an important role in the country's history and are renowned for their majestic monuments, vibrant culture, and bustling souks.

This private tour operates with a minimum of 2 participants and includes a chauffeur-driven car and a local English-speaking guide in each city. End your journey with a relaxing beach stay in the seaside resort of Agadir.



DAY 1 : CASABLANCA

Welcome to Casablanca! Upon arrival at the airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel with assistance. In the afternoon, set out to discover Morocco's vibrant economic capital. Your tour includes the impressive Hassan II Mosque, Place des Nations Unies, the Medina, Place Mohamed V, the Central Market, the area surrounding the Royal Palace, the residential district of Anfa, and the beautiful Ain Diab Corniche, lined with swimming pools and inviting seaside restaurants. Visit the Sacré-Coeur Cathedral, set within the lovely Parc de la Ligue Arabe. Today, the cathedral is admired for its stunning stained-glass windows, whose installation was delayed due to World War II. Enjoy dinner at your hotel.

Night in Casablanca : Oum Palace 4* or similar



BEST OF MOROCCO - 12 DAYS / 11 NIGHTS

DAY 2 : CASABLANCA - RABAT - MEKNES (APPROX. 3H30)

Depart early for Rabat, the "Imperial Garden City" and administrative capital of the Kingdom. Discover the Kasbah des Oudayas, a former fortified military camp, and stroll through Rabat's vibrant and colorful medina, where getting a little lost is all part of the experience. Explore the Oudayas Garden, created in 1920 by a French architect at the request of the Resident General of Morocco. Designed in Andalusian style, it offers a peaceful retreat from the city's bustle. Continue to the iconic Hassan Tower and the remains of the Hassan Mosque, along with the splendid Mohammed V Mausoleum. Admire the Mechouar, as well as the ramparts and walls surrounding the Royal Palace. Continue to Meknes, often called the "Moroccan Versailles," founded in the late 17th century by Moulay Ismail. Visit Bab El Mansour, considered the most beautiful gateway in Morocco, and discover the Dar Jamai Museum. Dinner at the hotel.

Night in Meknes : Le Z Meknes 4* or similar

DAY 3 : MEKNES - VOLUBILIS - FEZ (APPROX. 2H30)

Depart for Fez. En route, visit the holy city of Moulay Driss Zerhoun, considered the first Muslim city in North Africa and named after its founder, Moulay Driss. Perched at an altitude of 550 meters and spread across two hills, the town overlooks lush green plains. Continue to the Roman ruins of Volubilis, once the capital of Mauretania and founded in the 3rd century BC. This remarkable archaeological site, once a thriving Roman outpost, is adorned with impressive monuments and offers a fascinating glimpse into a city shaped by centuries of cultural exchange, from Antiquity to the arrival of Islam. Arrive in Fez and visit the Merinid Tombs for a panoramic view over the old medina. Check in at your hotel and enjoy dinner.

Night in Fez : Hotel Menzeh Zalagh 4* or similar

DAY 4 : FEZ

Spend the day discovering Fès, Morocco's first imperial city, renowned for its UNESCO-listed medina. Explore Fès el-Bali, the historic heart of the old town, founded in the 8th century and home to architectural treasures such as the Andalusian Mosque and the Quaraouiyyine Mosque. Surrounded by ancient ramparts, it is also famous for its lively souks. Take a break from the medina's bustle at the peaceful Jnan Sbil Garden, created in the 18th century by Sultan Moulay Abdallah and linking the old city to the modern districts. Continue to the Medersa Attarine and admire its intricate zellige tiles, marble, and finely carved cedar wood, showcasing the beauty of Moroccan craftsmanship. End the day by discovering the modern side of Fès, with its wide boulevards and vibrant atmosphere. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Night in Fez : Hotel Menzeh Zalagh 4*

DAY 5 : FEZ - BENI MELLAL - MARRAKECH (APPROX. 8HR)

Depart Fez and drive through the magnificent landscapes of the Middle Atlas to Beni Mellal. En route, stop in Immouzer du Kandar, nicknamed the "Pearl of the Atlas." Surrounded by mountain ranges and known for its spectacular waterfall, this small town is a haven for nature lovers in every season. Continue to Ifrane, often called "Little Switzerland" for its alpine-style architecture, cool climate, and lush surroundings. The town is also known for its vast national park, home to beautiful cedar forests typical of Morocco. Pass through Beni Mellal, located at the western edge of the Middle Atlas, south of the fertile Tadla plain. This region is an important agricultural hub, producing fruits, vegetables, and cereals that support its prosperous economy. Arrive in Marrakech in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Night in Marrakech : Dellarosa Hotel Suites & Spa 4* or similar

DAY 6 : MARRAKECH

Spend the day discovering Marrakech, the second oldest imperial city, known as the “Pearl of the South.” Nestled near the snow-capped Atlas Mountains, this historic Berber city has beautifully preserved its medieval charm. In the morning, explore its main landmarks, including the Koutoubia Mosque with its iconic minaret, the serene Menara Gardens, the Marrakech Museum, and the elegant Bahia Palace. In the afternoon, wander through the vibrant and colorful souks, filled with traditional crafts and local goods. Continue to the famous Djemaa El Fna Square, a lively open-air theater where storytellers, musicians, spice sellers, fortune-tellers, and snake charmers create an unforgettable atmosphere. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Night in Marrakech : Dellarosa Hotel Suites & Spa 4*

DAY 7 : MARRAKECH - AGADIR (APPROX. 3H15)

Arrive at the seaside resort of Agadir, located at the foot of the Anti-Atlas Mountains and overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. Agadir is one of Morocco’s most popular and pleasant coastal destinations. Rebuilt in the late 20th century after the 1960 earthquake, it is now a modern, dynamic city with the atmosphere of a fully equipped European-style seaside resort, offering beautiful world-class hotels and excellent facilities. Check in at your selected hotel.

Night in Agadir

DAY 8, 9, 10, 11 : AGADIR

Four days of relaxation on the beach or for optional tours.

Stay in Agadir

DAY 12 : AGADIR - DEPART

End of your trip. Transfer to Agadir airport for departure.
