12 DAYS / 11 NIGHTS

For the ultimate safari experience, combining Kenya and Tanzania offers breathtaking scenery and vast savannas teeming with wildlife. Tanzania is home to the Serengeti, arguably the most famous national park in Africa, while Kenya boasts the Masai Mara, one of the best locations in the world to observe big cats. This tour provides the option of set departures (joining a 6 passenger jeep) or a private guide-driver with private jeep (minimum 2 passengers)

DAY 1: NAIROBI

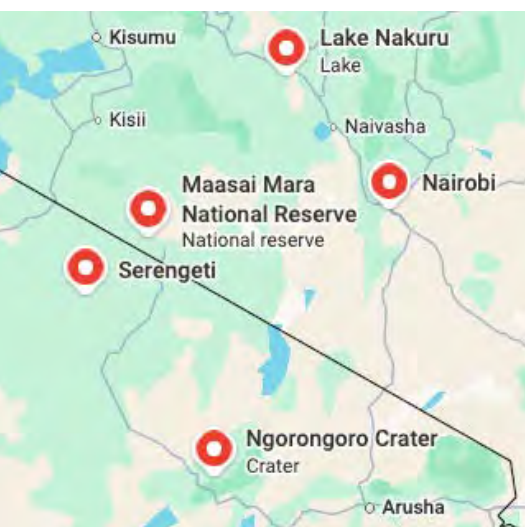
JAMBO - KARIBU!! Welcome to Kenya. Our local representative will warmly meet you upon arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and transfer you to your hotel in the heart of the central business district.

Overnight: Sarova Stanley Hotel 4+*

DAY 2: NAIROBI - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Morning pick up and drive to Lake Nakuru with a brief stop at the Rift Valley view point. Arrive at the lodge to a very warm welcome, check-in, then lunch. This afternoon, depart on a game viewing drive. The park is one of the best game viewing parks with various animal species including prides of lion, Cape buffalo, the endangered Rothschild giraffe, zebra, impalas, and the elusive leopard among many others. Over 300 bird species have been recorded here too. Lake Nakuru National Park is one of the best places to see the endangered black and white Rhino. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight. Distance: 163km – drive 3h45

Overnight: Mbweha Safari Camp 4+*





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DAY 3: LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK - MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

After an early morning breakfast drive to the Masai Mara Game Reserve offering wonderful scenery and plenty of game. Arrive at the intimate 20-tent Tipilikwani Camp in time for lunch. This afternoon is the moment you've been longing for – depart on an exciting game viewing drive. The rolling plains and grasslands stretching far into the horizons as far as the eye can see is home to the black-maned lion, the savannah elephant, the Cape buffalo, wildebeest, the elusive leopard, cheetah, the spotted & striped hyena, rhino, topi, Burchell's zebra, and the Masai giraffe among many others. The Mara game reserve is one that can never disappoint. Return to the camp for dinner and overnight. Distance: 240km – drive 4h50

Overnight: Tipilikwani Luxury Mara Camp 3+*

DAY 4: MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, depart on your day's adventure with exciting game viewing in search of the Big Five that the Masai Mara is famous for: lion, African elephant, Cape buffalo, leopard, and black rhino. With luck, you may even witness a leopard or cheetah in a thrilling chase and kill. Return to camp for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Tipilikwani Luxury Mara Camp 3+*

DAY 5: MASAI MARA RESERVE - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK (CHANGE OF COUNTRY)

Today begins very early. Enjoy a hearty breakfast before departing with a picnic lunch via the Isebania & Siriri border. Your driver-guide will assist with immigration procedures, after which you will transfer to a Tanzania-registered vehicle with a Tanzanian driver-guide and continue to Serengeti National Park.

Covering 14,763 square kilometers, the world-famous Serengeti is Tanzania's oldest national park and is renowned for the annual migration of wildebeest and zebra. Seeking fresh pasture, the herds move north from their breeding grounds across the southern plains, with some crossing the crocodile-infested Grumeti River through the western corridor, while others head northeast toward the Lobo Hills and into the Masai Mara. Arrive at the lodge in the early evening in time for dinner and overnight. Note: This is a long drive of approximately 10 hours or more, depending on road conditions and time spent at border control.

Overnight: Serengeti Heritage Camp 4*

DAY 6: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast depart with a picnic lunch for a full day of game viewing in the vast Serengeti plains. In the early morning and evening light, the Serengeti landscape is stunningly beautiful. Return to your lodge late afternoon for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Serengeti Heritage Camp 4*

DAY 7: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK - NGORONGORO CONSERVATION

After breakfast, depart for Ngorongoro with a brief stop at Olduvai Gorge, one of the world's most important prehistoric sites, to learn about human evolution. Continue to the crater rim and arrive at the lodge in time for lunch. Spend the afternoon relaxing and enjoying breathtaking views of the Ngorongoro Crater, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's great natural wonders. The 610-metre-deep caldera is home to abundant wildlife, including the endangered black rhino and a high concentration of predators. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. Note: A warm jacket/cardigan is highly recommended. Distance: 230 km – Drive: 4h30.

Overnight: Ngorongoro Coffee Lodge 4*



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DAY 8: NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

After breakfast descend some 610 meters into the crater for a full day of game-viewing with picnic lunch. Prides of lions, herds of Cape buffalo, impala, Thompson gazelles, rhino, giraffe, golden & black-backed jackal, zebra, cheetah, leopard, and the spotted hyena freely roam on the crater floor plain. Return late afternoon to your lodge. Enjoy dinner and overnight. Distance: 110km – drive 2h00

Overnight: Ngorongoro Coffee Lodge 4*

DAY 9: NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA - TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Depart to Tarangire National Park, famous for its baobab trees, to arrive at your lodge for lunch. This afternoon, depart on an exciting game drive. Herds of up to 300 elephants scratch the dry Tarangire riverbed for underground streams, while migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest, and eland crowd the shrinking lagoons. It's the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem. Enjoy dinner and overnight at your lodge. Distance: 110km – drive 2h00

Overnight: Tarangire Sopa Lodge 3+*

DAY 10: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK - AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK (CHANGE OF COUNTRY)

Enjoy an early morning breakfast then depart via the Namanga border where you will clear immigration formalities and change into Kenyan-registered vehicles and Kenyan driver-guide and proceed to Amboseli National Park. Arrive at the lodge to a very warm welcome and enjoy lunch. Depart on an afternoon game drive. Amboseli is home to lions, buffalo, cheetah, giraffe, baboon, gazelle, hippo, and wildebeest. Enjoy dinner and overnight at your lodge. Distance: 255km – drive 4h00

Overnight: Amboseli Serena Safari Lodge 4*

DAY 11: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Morning and afternoon game drives. Amboseli offers some of the most breath-taking views in Africa - one of the best places for a photogenic view of Mount Kilimanjaro (weather permitting). The park is famous for large herds of giant elephants. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

Overnight: Amboseli Serena Safari Lodge 4*

DAY 12: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK - NAIROBI - DEPART

After breakfast, transfer to Nairobi for lunch before heading to Jomo Kenyatta Intl Airport for your onward flight.
