THAILAND HIGHLIGHTS

10 DAYS / 9 NIGHTS

Explore Thailand's highlights on this 10-day tour from Bangkok to the north of the country. Travelling by private car with an English-speaking local guide is an excellent way to enjoy an authentic experience. Why not extend your trip with a seaside holiday on one of the many islands? And don't forget Angkor Wat in neighboring Cambodia, just an hour and a half's flight from Bangkok.



DAY 1 : ARRIVE IN BANGKOK

Welcome to Thailand! The legendary hospitality of the Thai people has earned them the nickname "the land of smiles". The country is bursting with activities, vibrant modern cities and dreamy tropical beaches, offering an experience full of fascinating contrasts. Arrival at Bangkok airport. Meet and greet and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

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DAY 2 : BANGKOK

Today, visit two of Bangkok's most important sites. The Wat Pho Reclining Buddha is a giant reclining Buddha covered in gold leaf. The Grand Palace is a highlight for any visitor to Bangkok. Located near the banks of the Chao Phraya (River of Kings), the Grand Palace is a perfect example of an ancient Siamese court. Within the palace grounds is the Temple of the Emerald Buddha (Wat Phra Kaew), home to Thailand's most precious Buddha image. After lunch, cruise the canals of Bangkok. Nicknamed the "Venice of the East" for its intricate network of canals and temples, life along the river and waterways is deeply rooted in the Thai way of life, offering a glimpse of a culture that has endured for centuries. Pay a visit to the famous Temple of Dawn, or Wat Arun, distinguished by its imposing 79- metre-high Prang. Return to hotel and evening at leisure. (B/L)

DAY 3 : BANGKOK

Early departure for a two-hour drive to the Damnoen-Saduak floating market. En route, visit to the Maeklong Railway Market. The Maeklong Railway Market has a railroad line running through the middle! While the products for sale are not placed on the railroad itself, they are placed very close to it. Whenever the train is about to pass, vendors hear the bell and immediately remove their awnings and products. Tourists and vendors gather very close, but far enough away, along the track to let the train pass safely by. Once the train has passed, the vendors place their goods back on the track. Continue to the Damnoen Saduak floating market, to discover the traditional Thai way of buying and selling goods. Return to Bangkok and free day in the afternoon. (B)

DAY 4 : BANGKOK - KANCHANABURI

Check-out from the hotel and depart to Kanchanaburi, famous for its Death Railway, built during the Second World War. The line crosses the Khwae Yai River via the Death Railway Bridge. Exhibits at the JEATH War Museum pay tribute to the prisoners of war who died building the bridge. Nearby, thousands of Allied soldiers are buried at the Kanchanaburi War Cemetery. Visit the war museum, the war cemetery and the River Kwai Bridge. Take a historic ride on the Death Train through lush forests. (B)

DAY 5 : KANCHANABURI – UTHAI THANI

After breakfast, visit to Erawan National Park, with the Erawan Waterfalls. Erawan is the largest and most beautiful waterfall in the region, on the banks of the River Kwai. The waterfall is some 2,000 meters high in total, divided into 7 levels, each with natural pools for swimming. You will have all morning to enjoy the beautiful scenery and take a refreshing dip in one of the many natural pools. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon, transfer to Uthai Thani and check-in your hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure. (B)

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DAY 6 : UTHAI THANI - SUKHOTHAI

Depart for Sukhothai. Visit Wat Chantaram, also known as the "Crystal Temple". Inside, the temple complex is built with mirrored tiles and columns. Nearby, visit Wat Tha Sung, also known as the Golden Castle. Lunch at a local restaurant. Continue to a local pier to board a traditional rice barge for a cruise along the Sakae Krang River. Sail along the waterway and admire the natural beauty and vibrant wildlife along the banks. Pay a visit to Wat Tham Khao Wong, made entirely of wood. Admire the beauty of the surrounding nature around the temple. Arrive in Sukhothai. Check in and rest of the day at leisure. (B/L)

DAY 7 : SUKHOTHAI - CHIANG MAI

Depart early for Sukhothai Historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the former capital of Thailand's first kingdom. Explore its impressive ancient ruins by bicycle, including Wat Mahathat, Wat Si Sawai, Wat Sa Si, Wat Traphang Ngoen, and the remarkable Wat Si Chum, home to a giant seated Buddha. This afternoon, continue by private transfer to Chiang Mai. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy a relaxing evening at leisure after the scenic journey. (B/L)

DAY 8 : CHIANG MAI

This morning, enjoy an authentic Northern Thai cooking experience. Visit the 150-year-old Raunkaew-Yanon family home in a traditional Thai neighborhood. Explore the Lanna-style house and garden, select fresh ingredients, and learn to prepare authentic Northern Thai dishes. Enjoy the delicious lunch you helped create with your host family. This afternoon, explore Chiang Mai's sacred temples. Visit Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, Chiang Mai's most revered hilltop temple, followed by Wat Chedi Luang, with its ancient pagoda ruins, Wat Phra Singh, home to the famous Phra Singh Buddha, and Wat Suan Dok, known for its elegant white chedis containing the ashes of Chiang Mai's former royal family. (B/L)

DAY 9 : CHIANG MAI

Set off to the Elephant Jungle Sanctuary, one of the best sanctuaries for sustainable and ethical treatment. Qualified guides give an insight into the behavior and personal history of the elephants. Elephant mahouts help participants enjoy incredible experiences, such as hand-feeding and bathing elephants. After lunch, return to hotel. (B/L)

DAY 10 : CHIANG MAI | DEPART

After breakfast, checkout and transfer to Chiang Mai airport. End of services. (B)
